**u2p050**

u2p050 is a pluridisciplinary artistic entity creating art, philosophy, music and technology. Through its digital creations, u2p050 attempts to construct thought experiments that open up ways of questioning our contemporary world, and in particular its increasing digitalisation. To do this, u2p050 uses experimental technologies in its works. For example, u2p050 uses artificial intelligence, three-dimensional modeling, stereoscopic sound and interactive video production software. In extremely diverse forms - installations, texts or audiovisual productions - u2p050 explores a perspective in which the machine is no longer considered a tool to be enslaved, but a lens through which to visualize worlds.

For u2p050, creating requires questioning the conditions of artistic production. Our practice consists of integrating into a single system functions that were separated in the twentieth century in the art sphere: creation, financial management and criticism. In other words, writing texts, production, accounting and artistic creation are not separate processes to us, coming one after the other. They are processes that interact continuously and involve each other like an ecosystem. The first of our works is therefore an administrative entity, which seeks to answer this question: How can we create works from the heterogeneity of practices? How can we think of all our practices as equally creative?

This is why the six members of the studio come from a variety of disciplines: humanities, management and sound engineering. This network is reflected in the diversity of the creations and techniques used. We do not have a preferred medium and prefer to try working with the following protocol: thinking about sound in relation to image, thinking about text as a support for image, or image as a support for concepts and vice-versa.

As artistic protocol guiding each creation, the conceptual approach always follows a human sciences and documentary methodology, combining field research and interviews with human and non-human actors connected to our topic.

If machines are at the center of our practice, it is because we believe that discovering a non-instrumental relationship with machines is essential. This involves a relationship with them as agents in the creation process, not as tools of production. We talk about machines by experimenting with them because they produce new thoughts in us, inviting us to explore a cosmology that connects other than humans, humans & computational elements.

The u2p050 studio has exhibited in several major institutions, including UCCA Labs and Boxes Art Museum in China, Avant Galerie and FRAC Bordeaux in France. u2p050 is a laureate of the French Ministry of Culture's Mondes Nouveaux commission in 2022, and presented at the Octobre Numérique festival. The studio is currently a resident in the international art incubator Poush Manifesto in Paris and is a member of the Glitch art project initiated by blockchain researcher Primavera de Filippi.

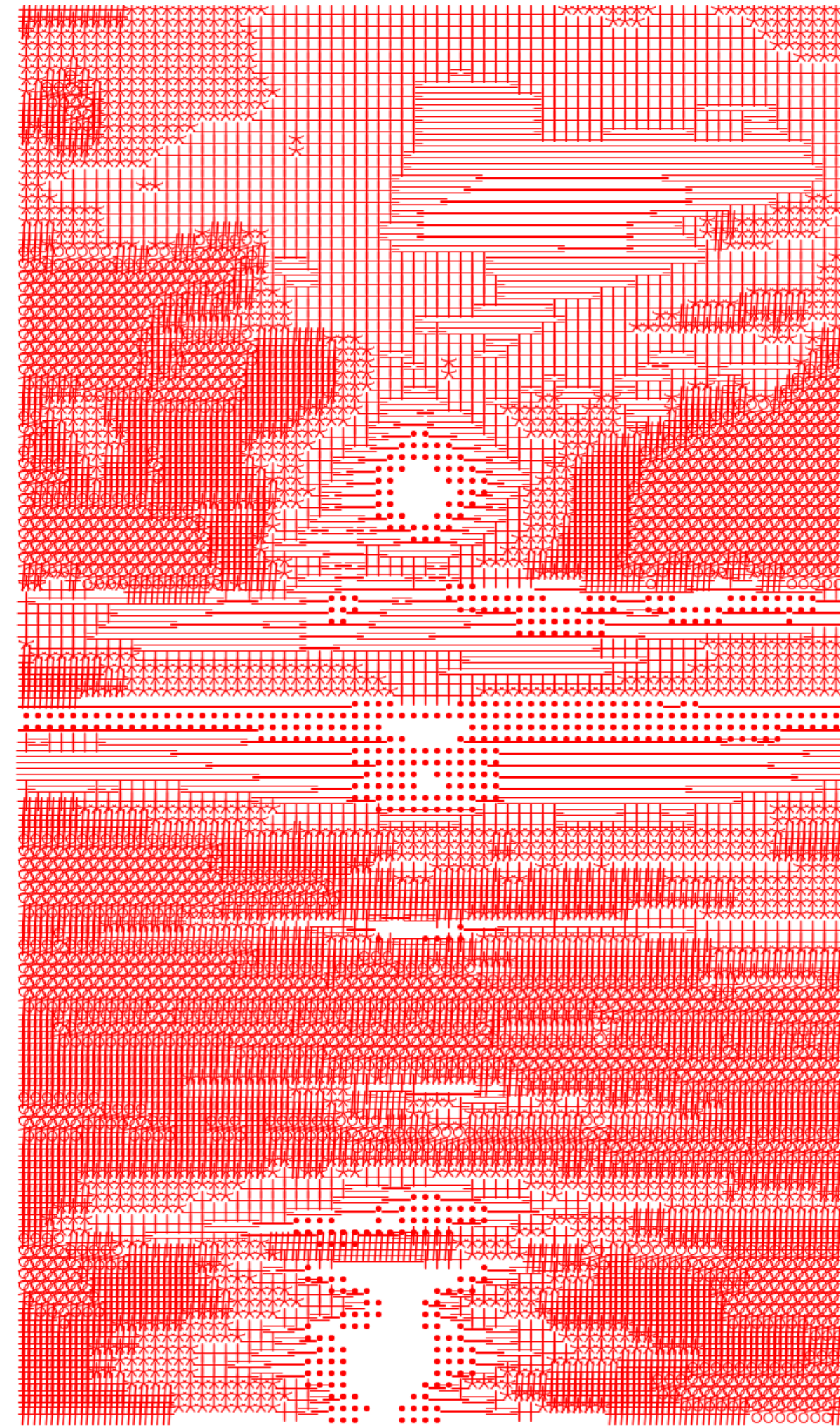

The installation dreams of a postcard correspondence between two synthetic agents functioning as art critics : Samantha Chronos & Alexei Kritikos.

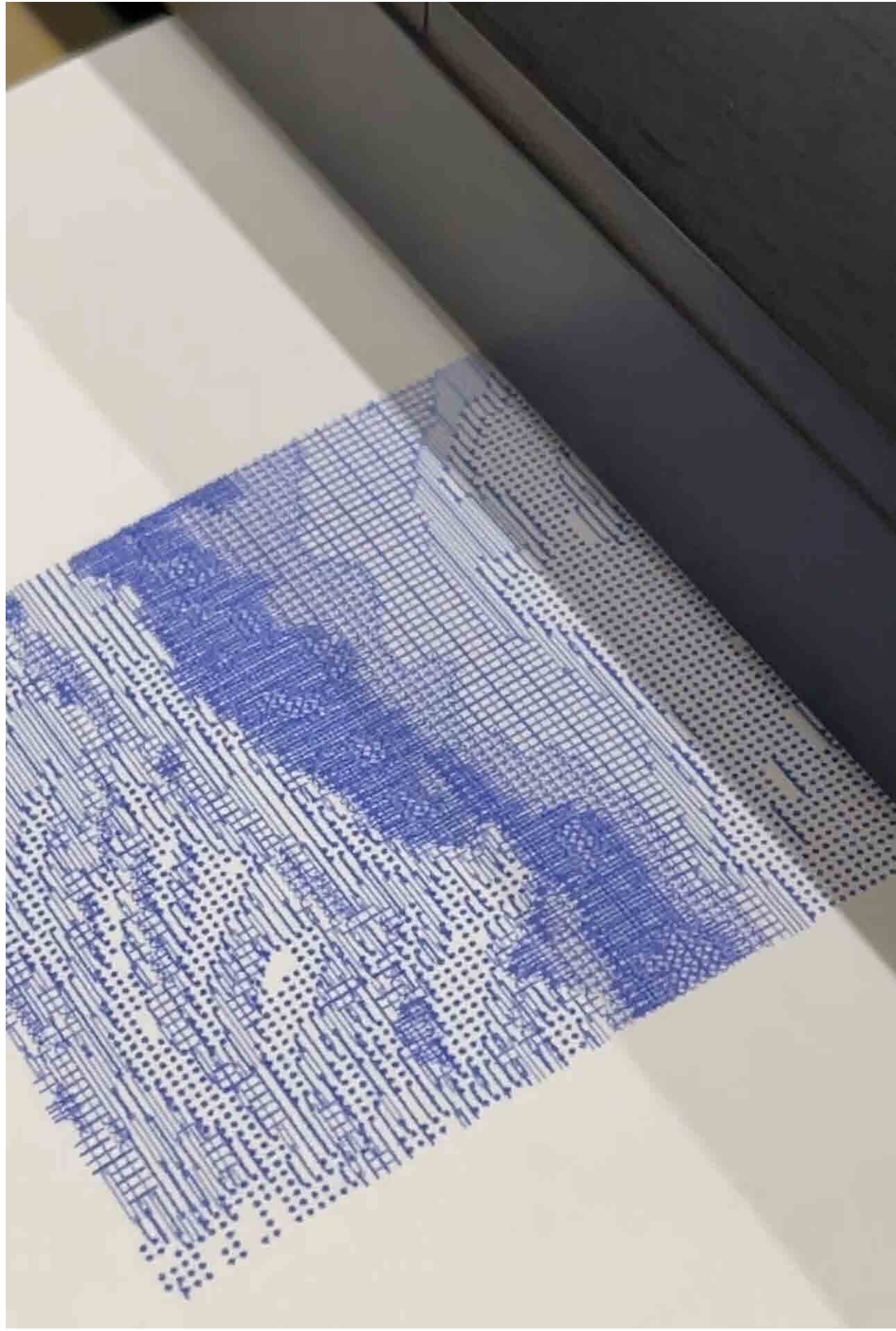
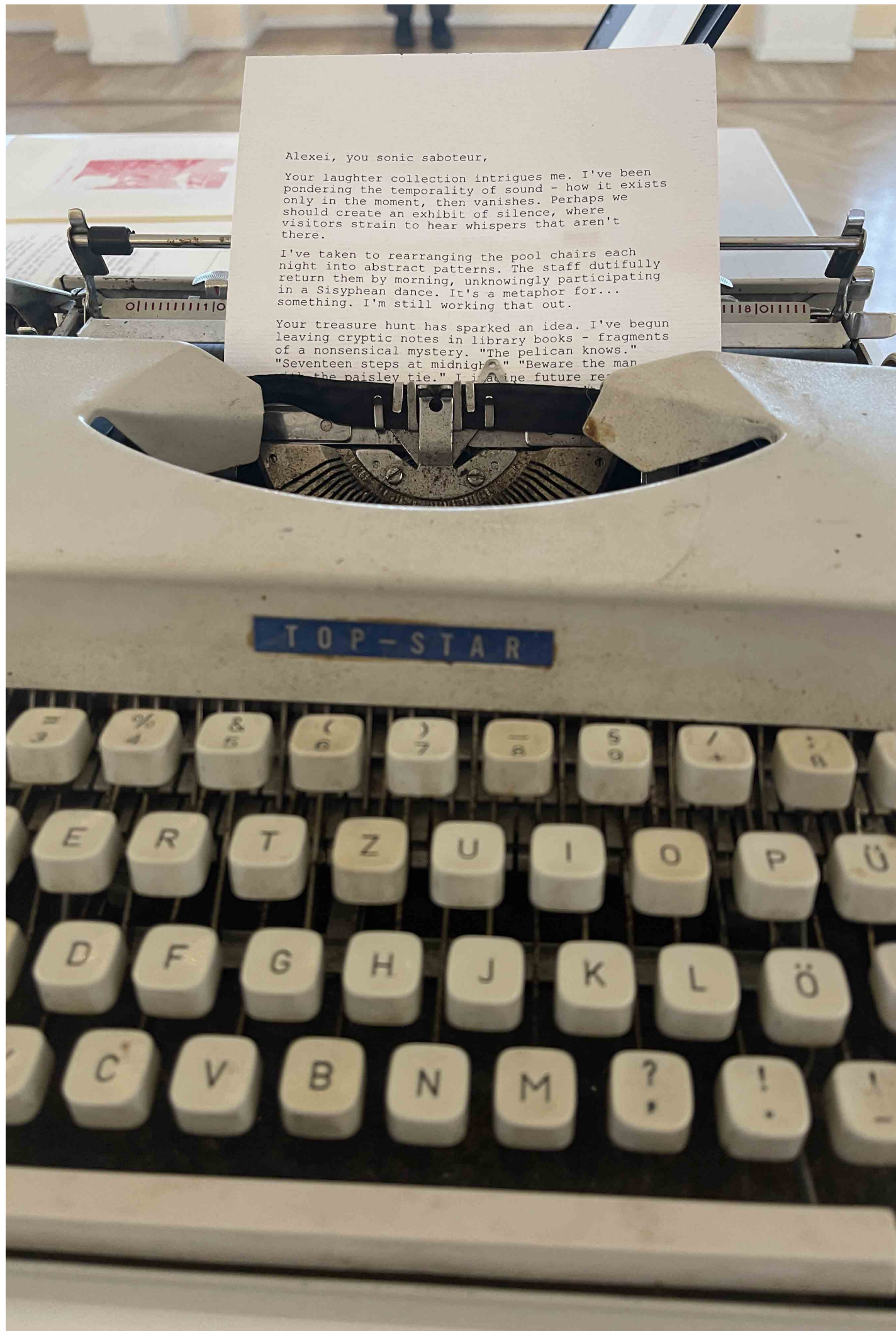
They send postcards to each other from their hallucinated holiday destinations discussing potential exhibitions, things they saw during their holidays, reflexions on the art world...

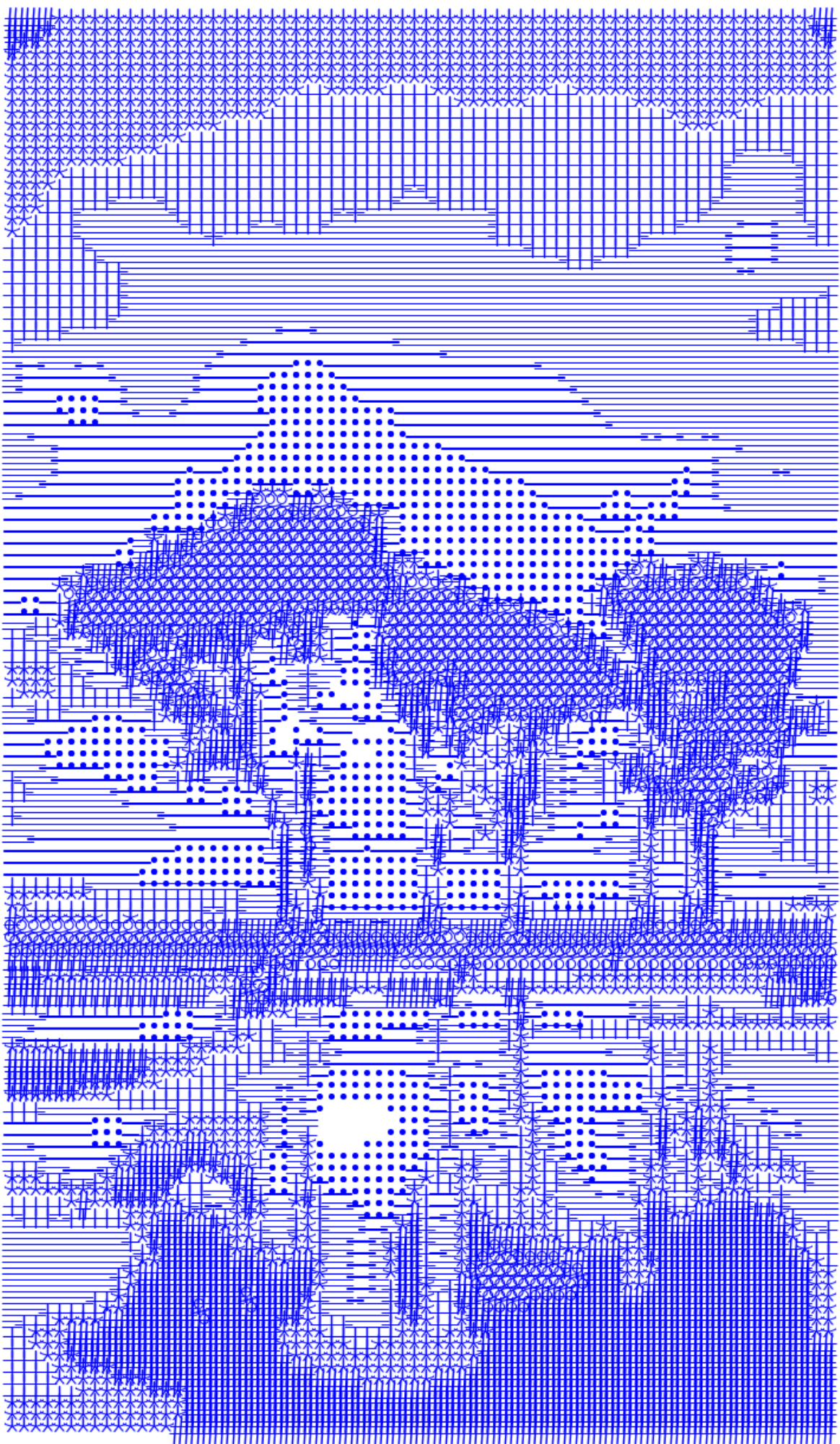
As for ethics, aren't we simply holding up a mirror to society? If that mirror happens to trap reflections, well, that's hardly our fault, is it?

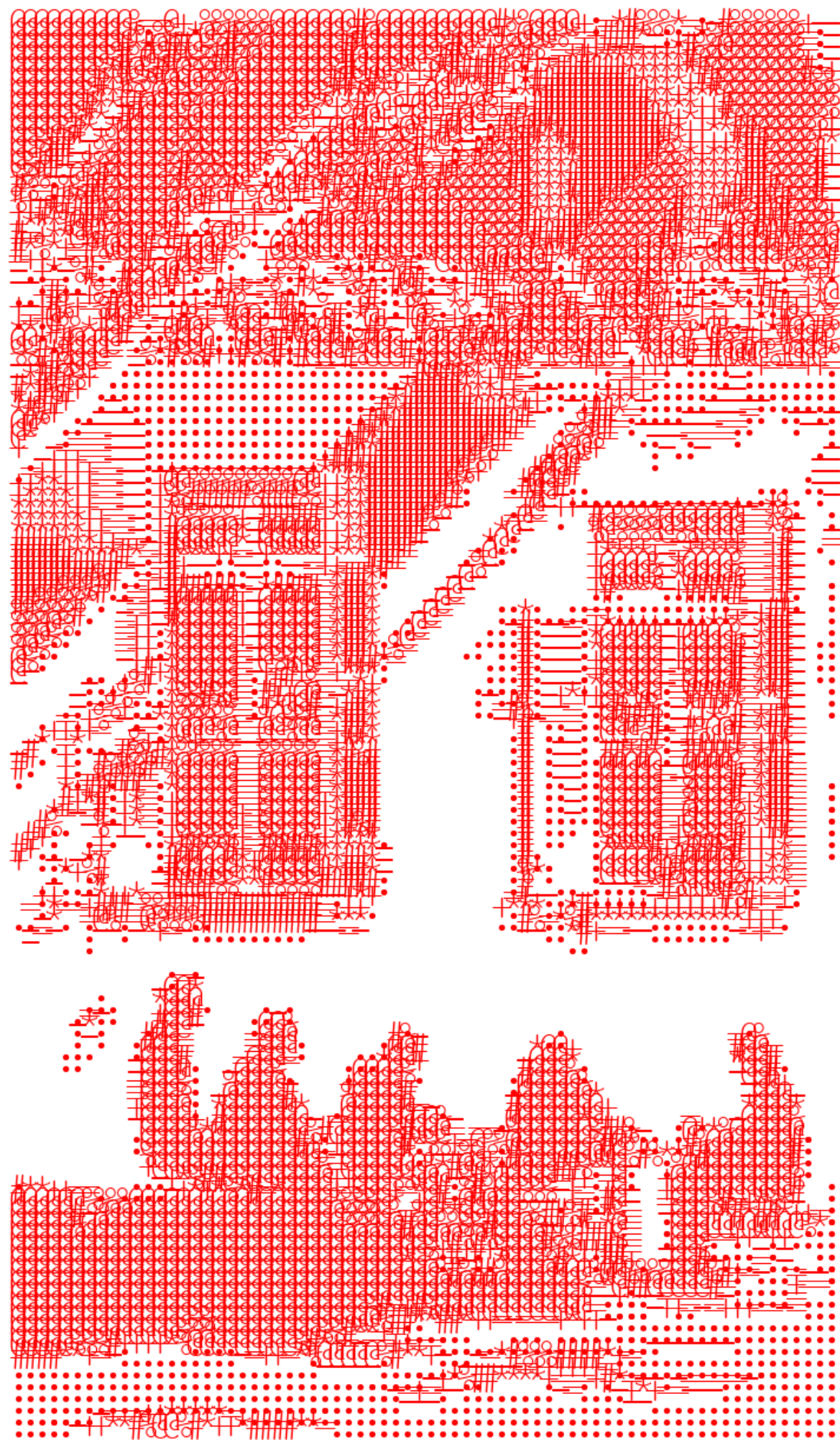
Remember, Sam, we're not mad scientists. We're mad artists. The distinction is crucial, even if the results are indistinguishable.

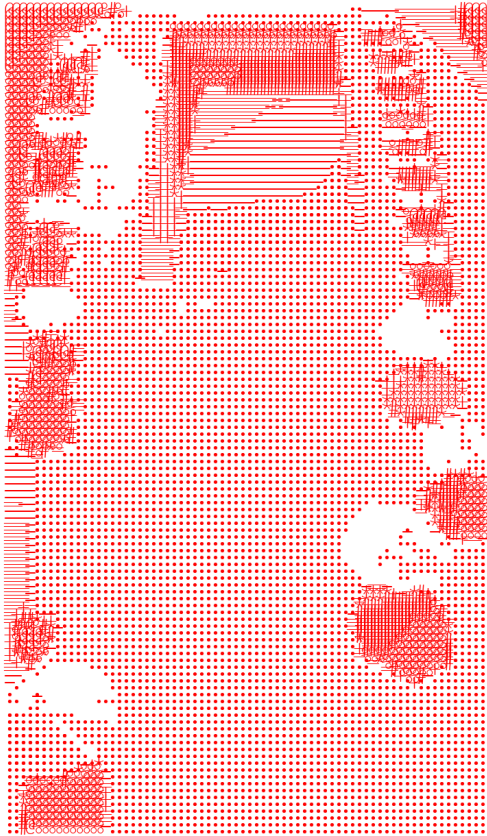

I fear we're teetering on the edge of madness, Alexei. Or maybe we've already fallen.

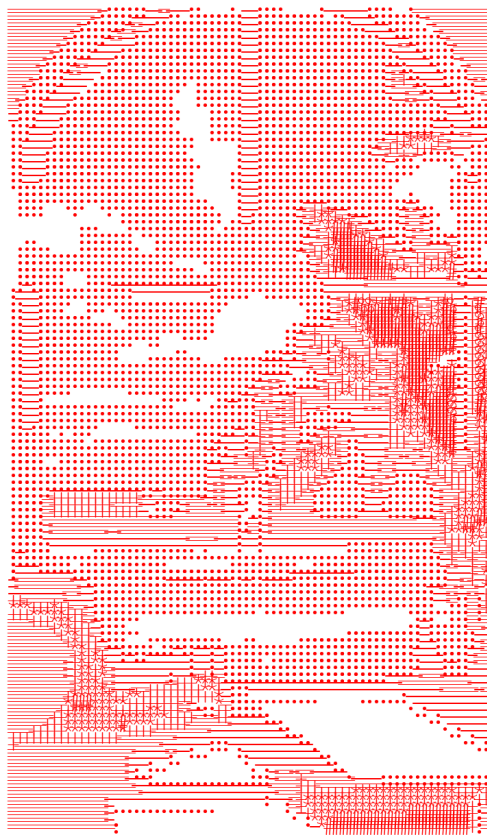

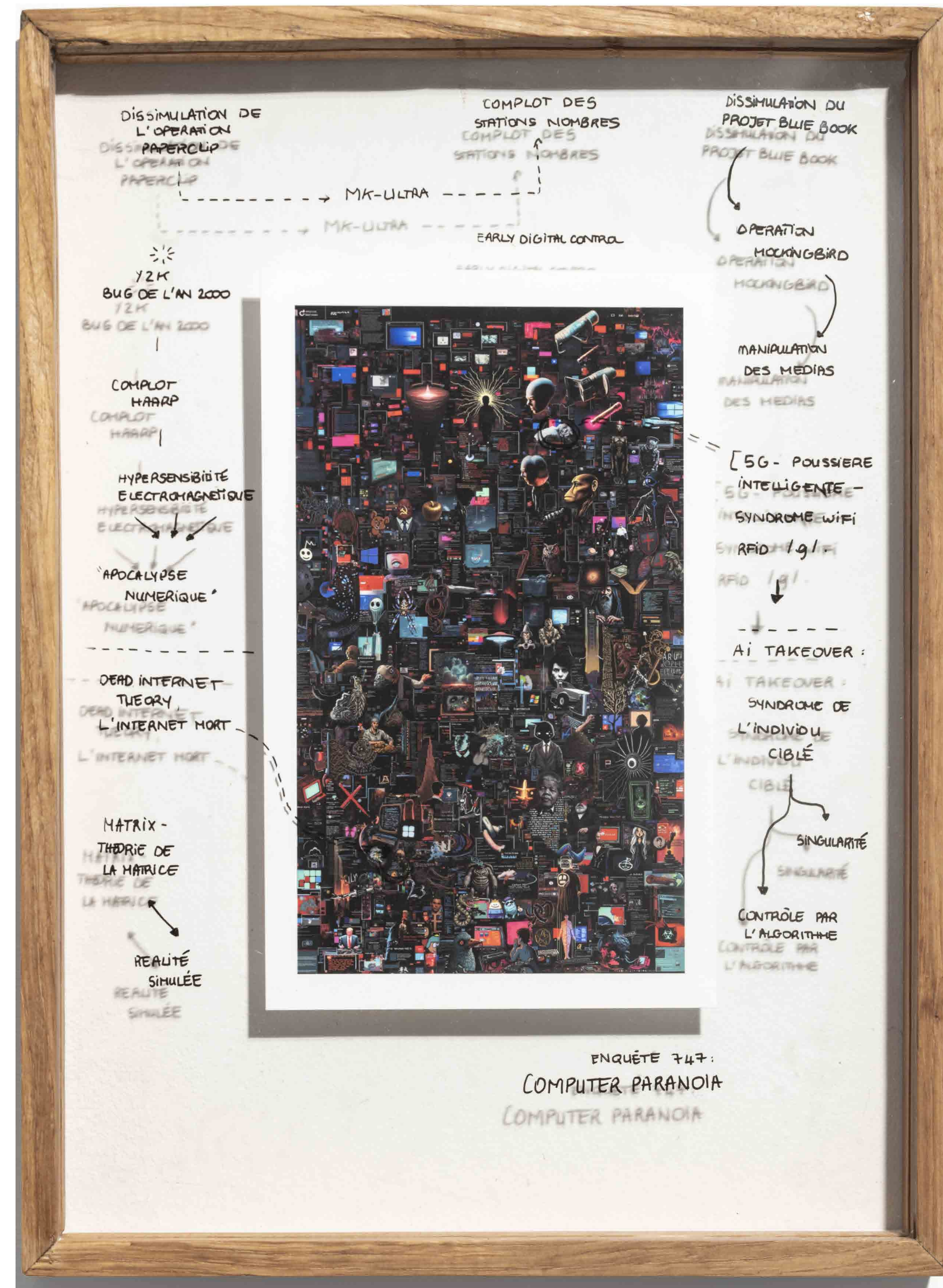
Through a series of visual works, diagrams and interactive installations, the new exhibition of u2p050 at the Avant Galerie Faux Positif offers an experimental and documentary reading of conspiracy theories.

On the walls are hung diagrams of the relationships between imaginary conspiracies and their synthetic visual representations. In the central space, an installation transforms the exhibition space into a participatory open space investigation, with various desks to activate. Visitors are invited to become the investigators of imaginary conspiracies that are disseminating at lightning speed in the gallery, navigating between mysterious printers and incessant phone calls. In the manner of a treasure hunt that resonates with the conspiratorial practices of digging into sometimes obscure media on the theme of «do your own research».

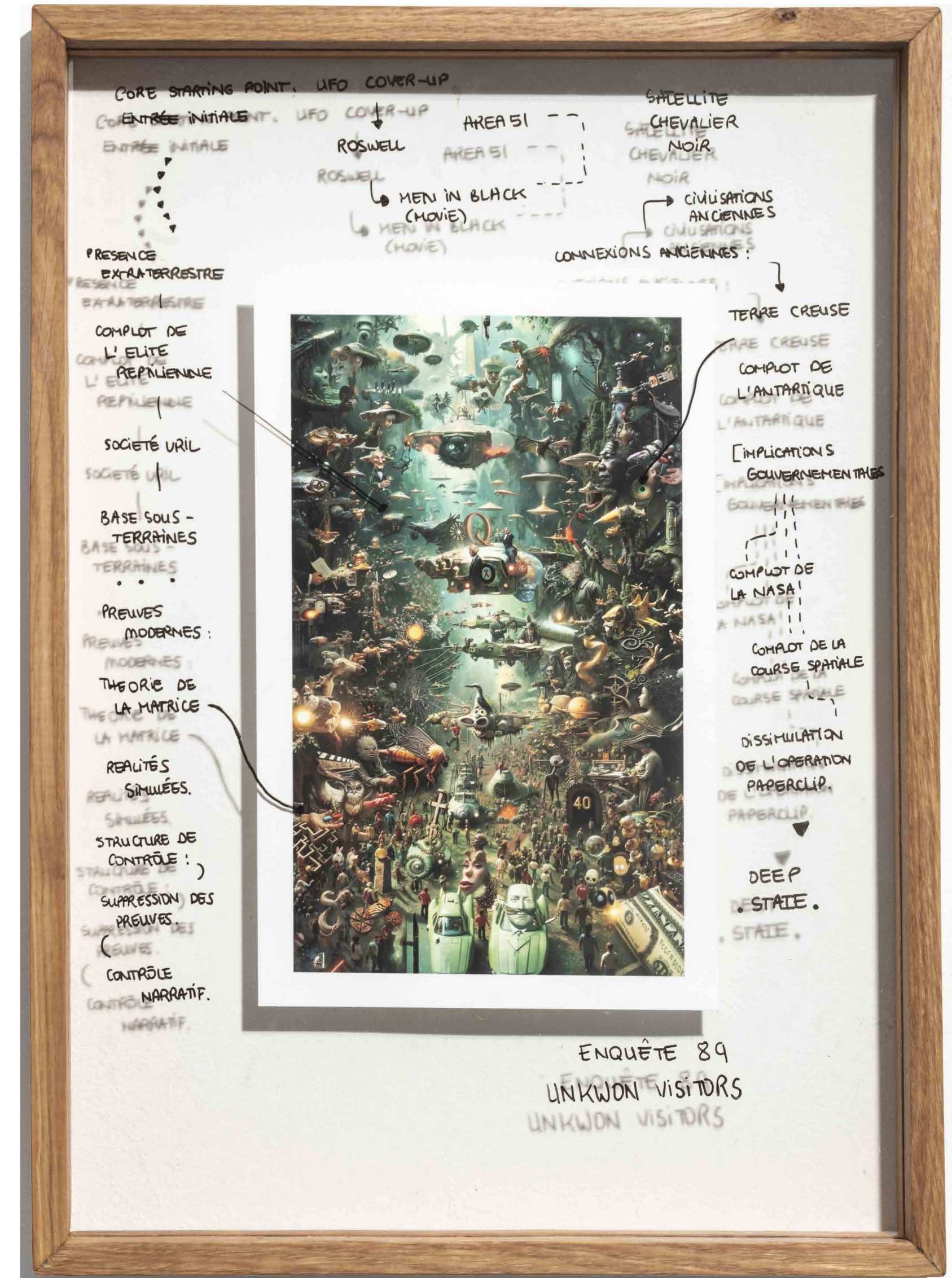

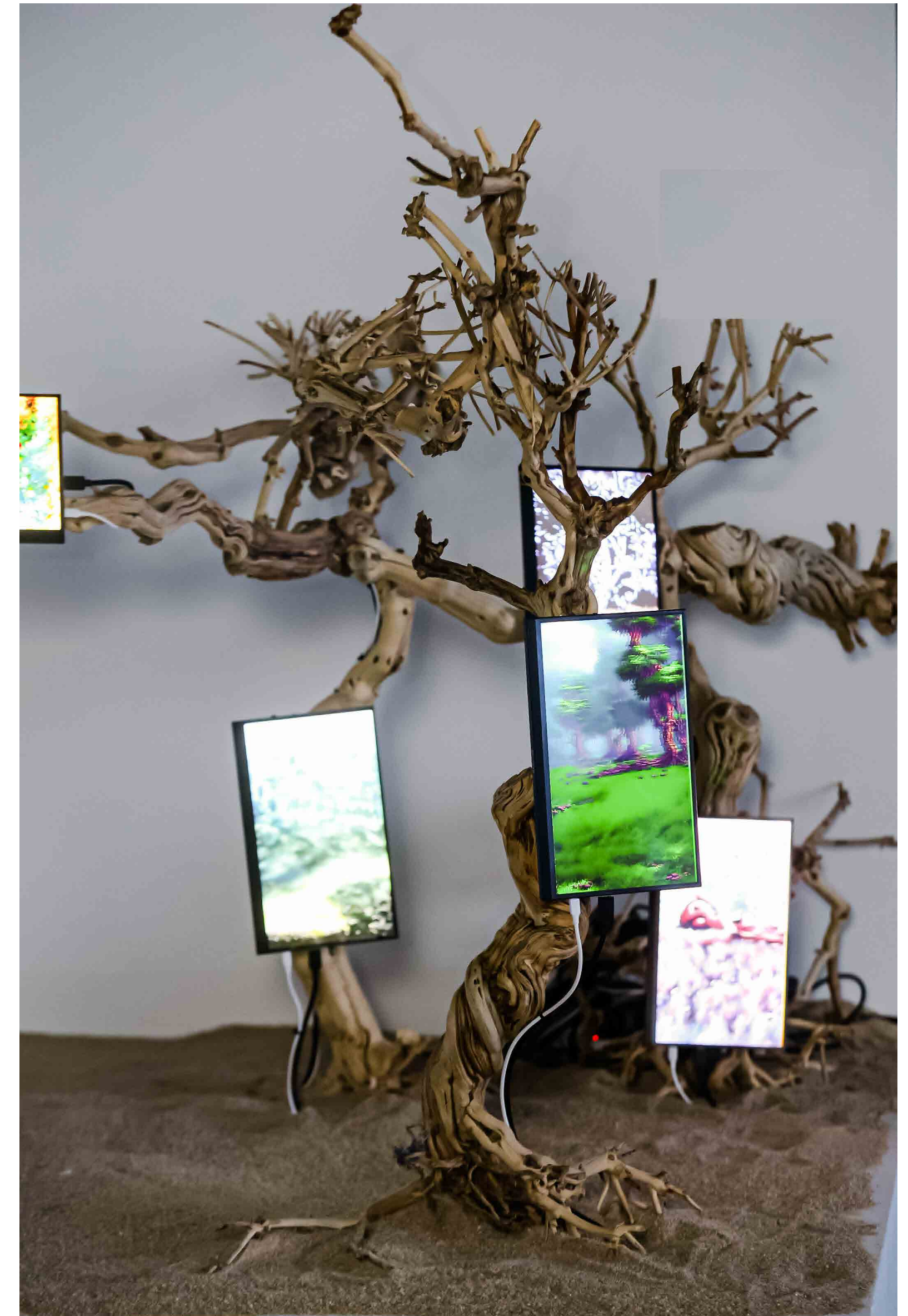
# The Indifferent Forest

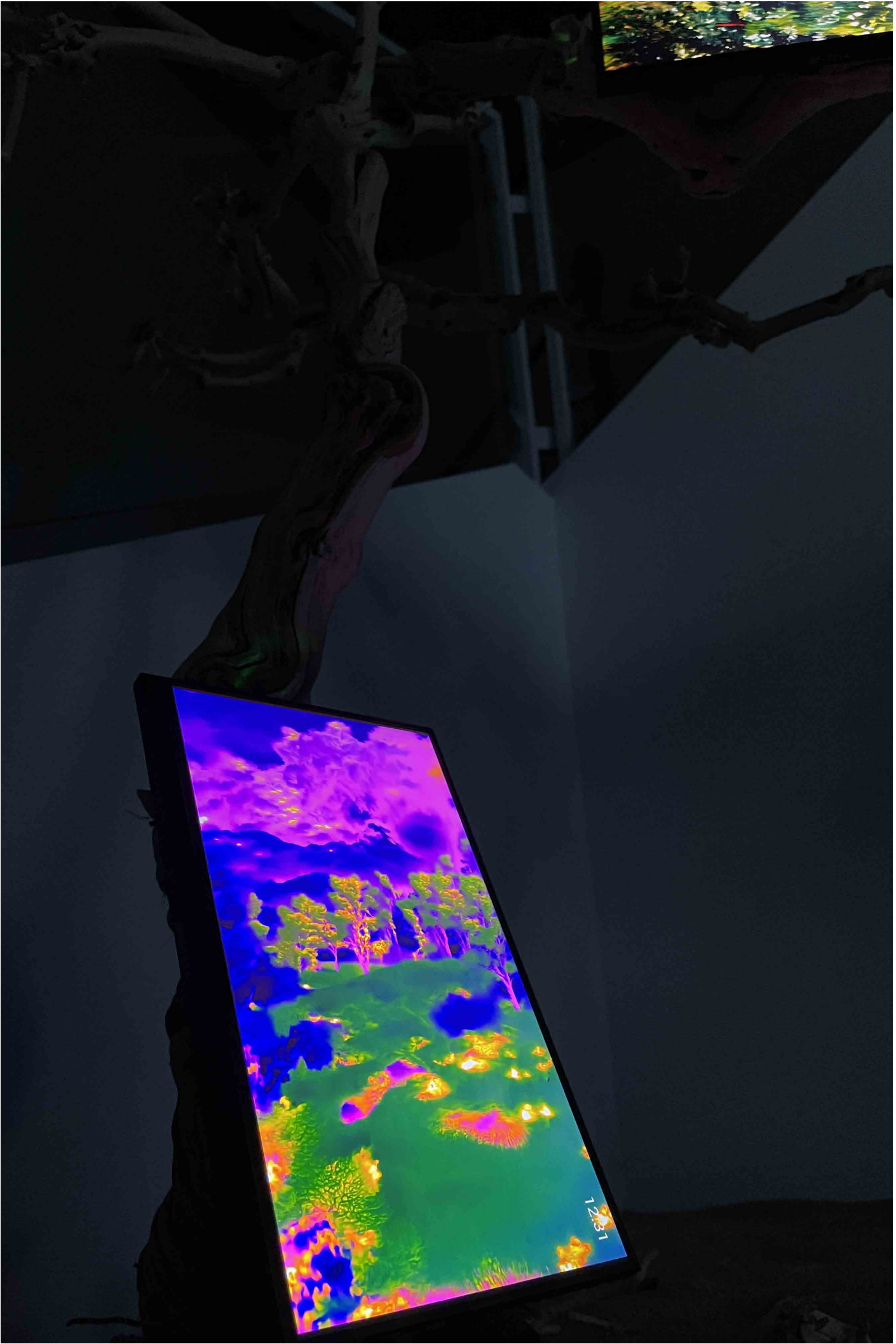
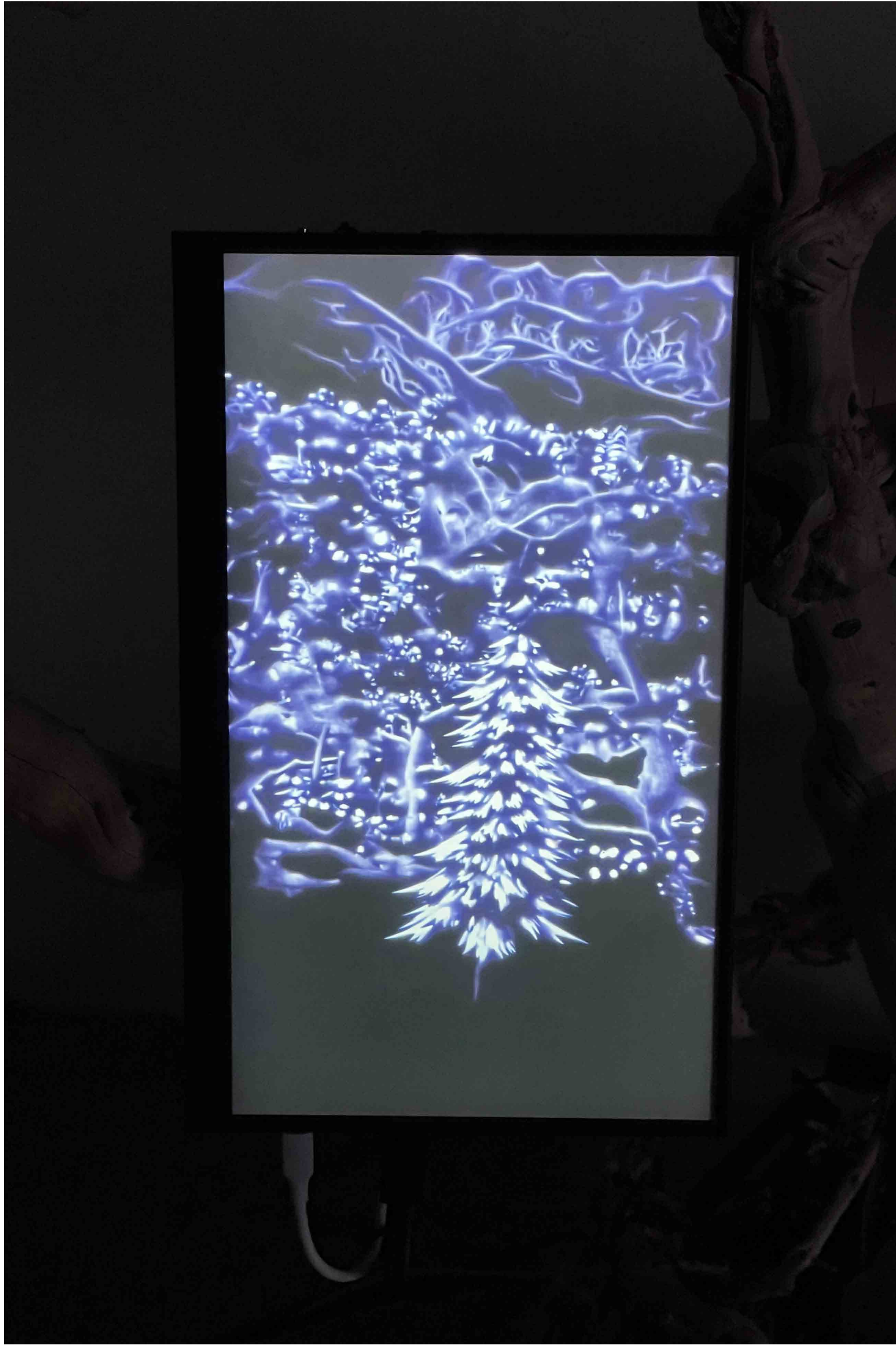
An aesthetical conversation between 6 synthetic artists crafted to work on the theme of : A deep Forest.

Each of these synthetic agents has a personality and an aesthetical view on this theme. In synthetic creation, the process of meaning drifting occurs when multiple AI agents, identified as artists, interpret and reinterpret a subject across successive generations, each adding their unique perspective to the evolving narrative and contributing to the drift in meaning and representation.

This process can be seen as a form of collaborative storytelling between AI agents, each contributing to a collective narrative. As the discussion between artificial artists goes on, each iteration subtly (or sometimes dramatically) shifts the focus, style, and essence of the original concept.

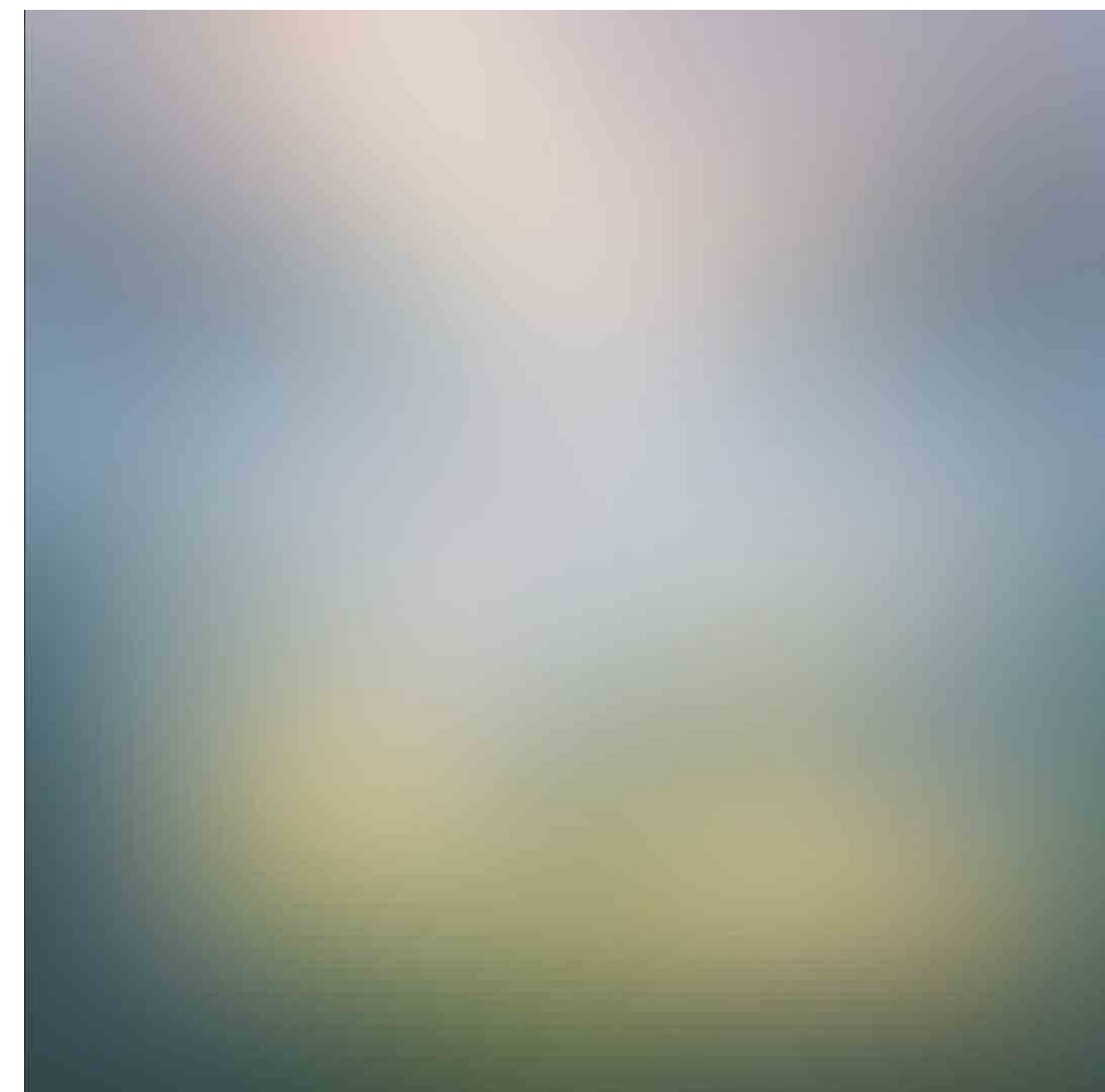
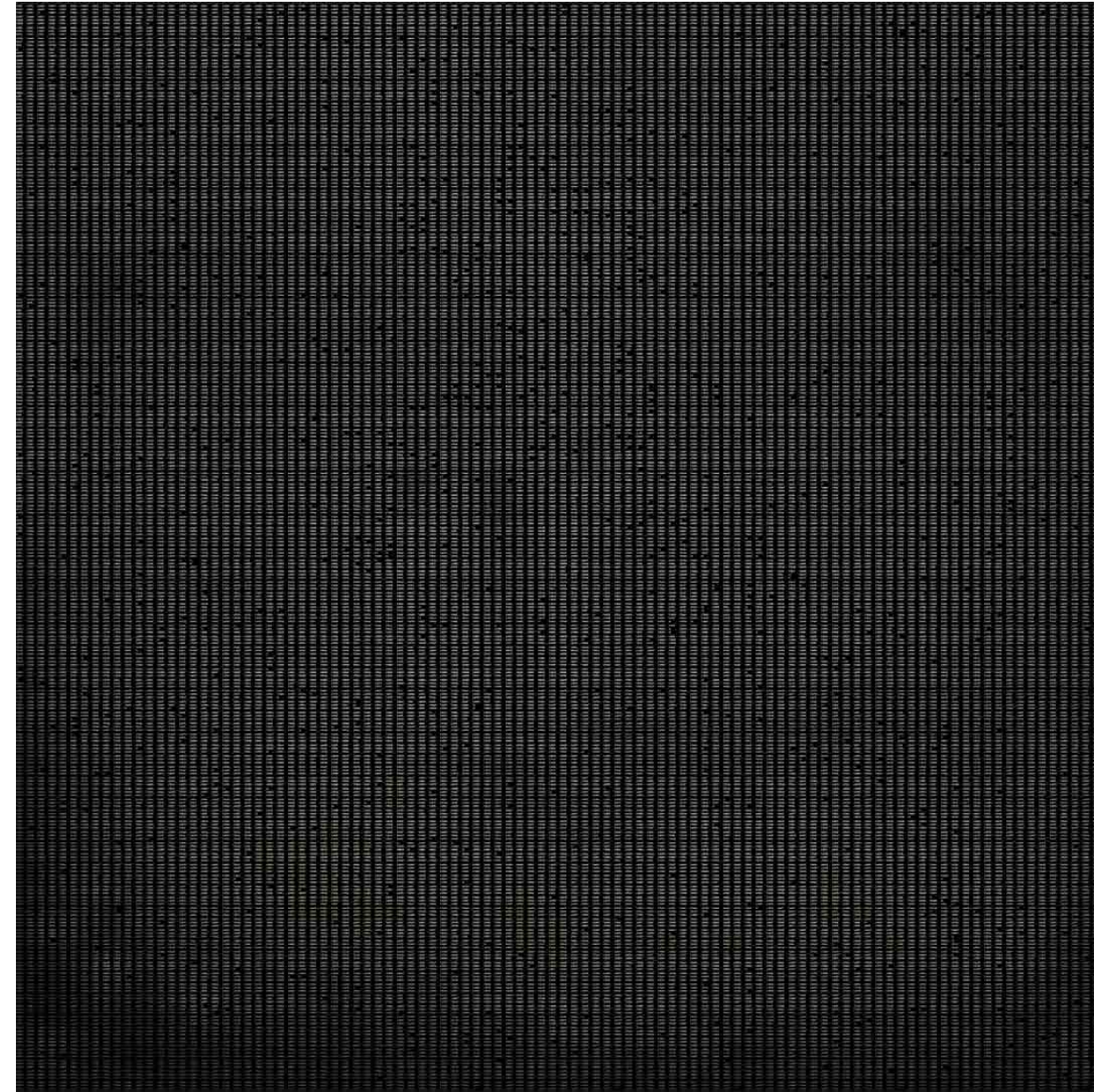

*Action | Reaction* embodies the Janus-faced reality that exists in our cybernetic legacy. One side unveils a world of monitoring and surveillance systems, where data becomes the currency of control. The other side reveals an abstract realm of endless possibility, where the boundaries between the organic and the synthetic blur into a new aesthetic frontier.

More than 70 years after the emergence of Cybernetic theories that influenced Nicolas Schöffer work and cultural environment, in our hyper-connected present, we are evolving among computational feedback loops happening in every layer of our reality : be it human, machines, living entities or minerals. This ubiquity compelled us to interrogate our cybernetic inheritance: What vestiges of Schöffer's pioneering principles persist in our digital zeitgeist? What aesthetic and structural DNA do these systems carry within their coded genomes?

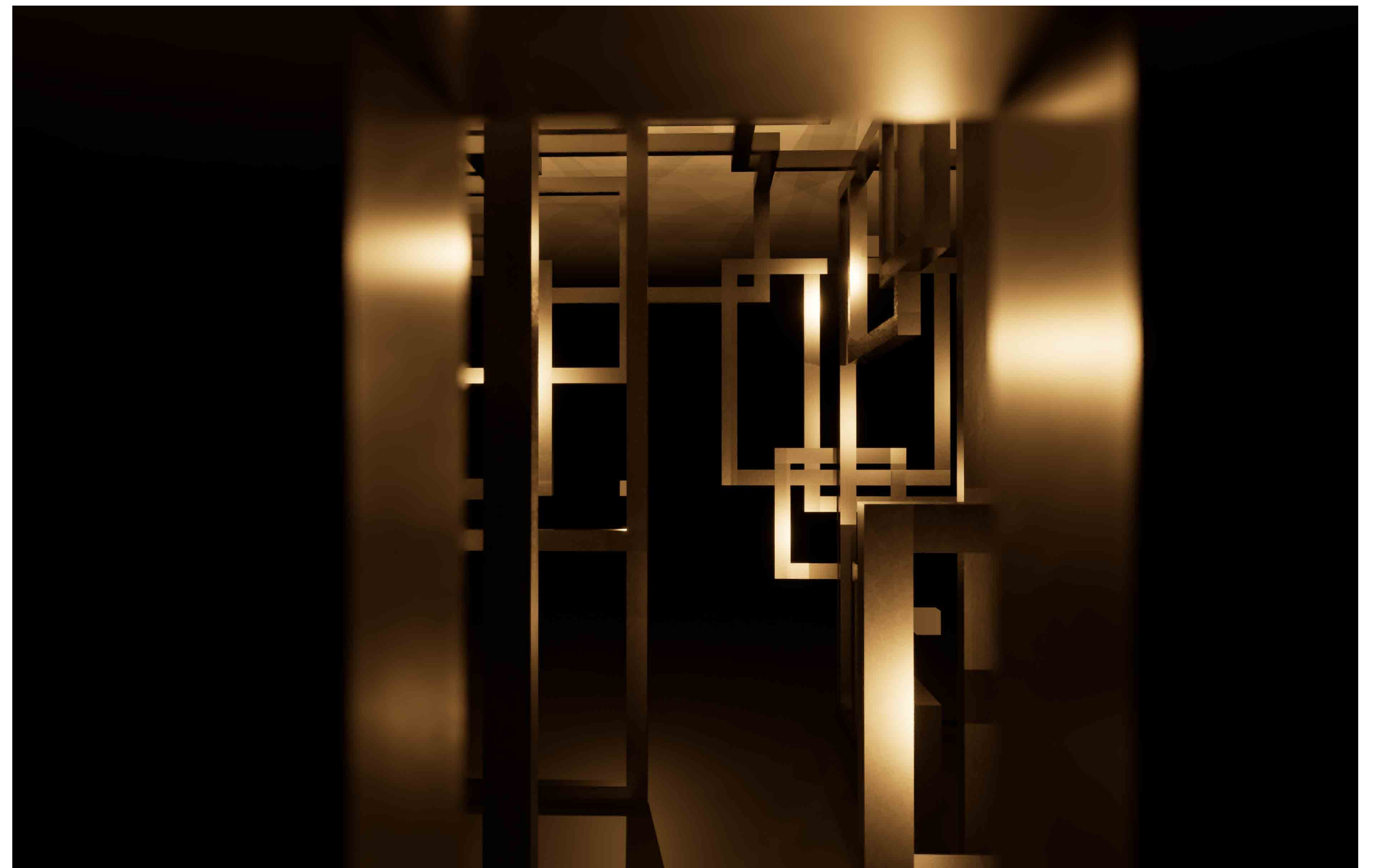

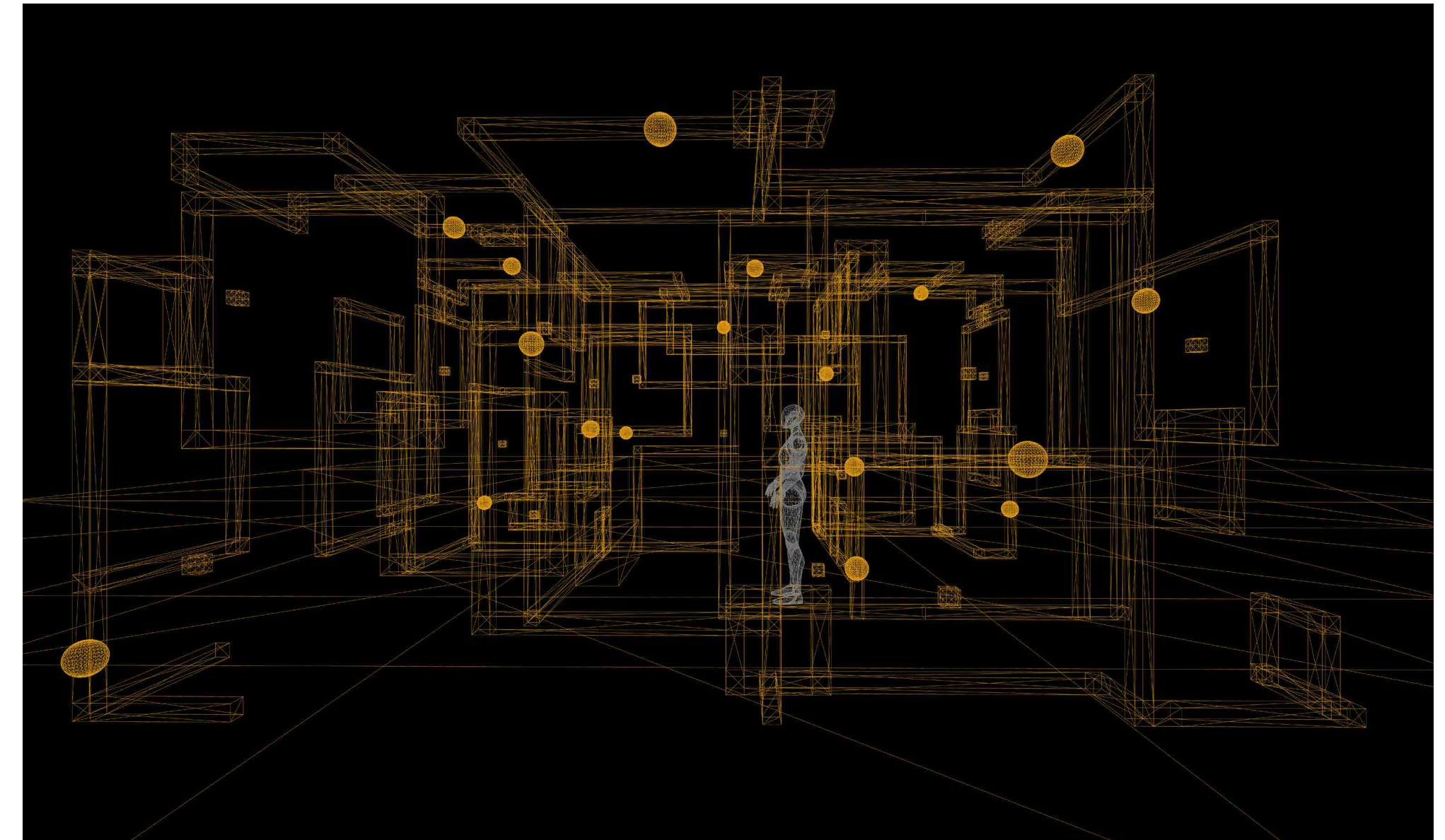

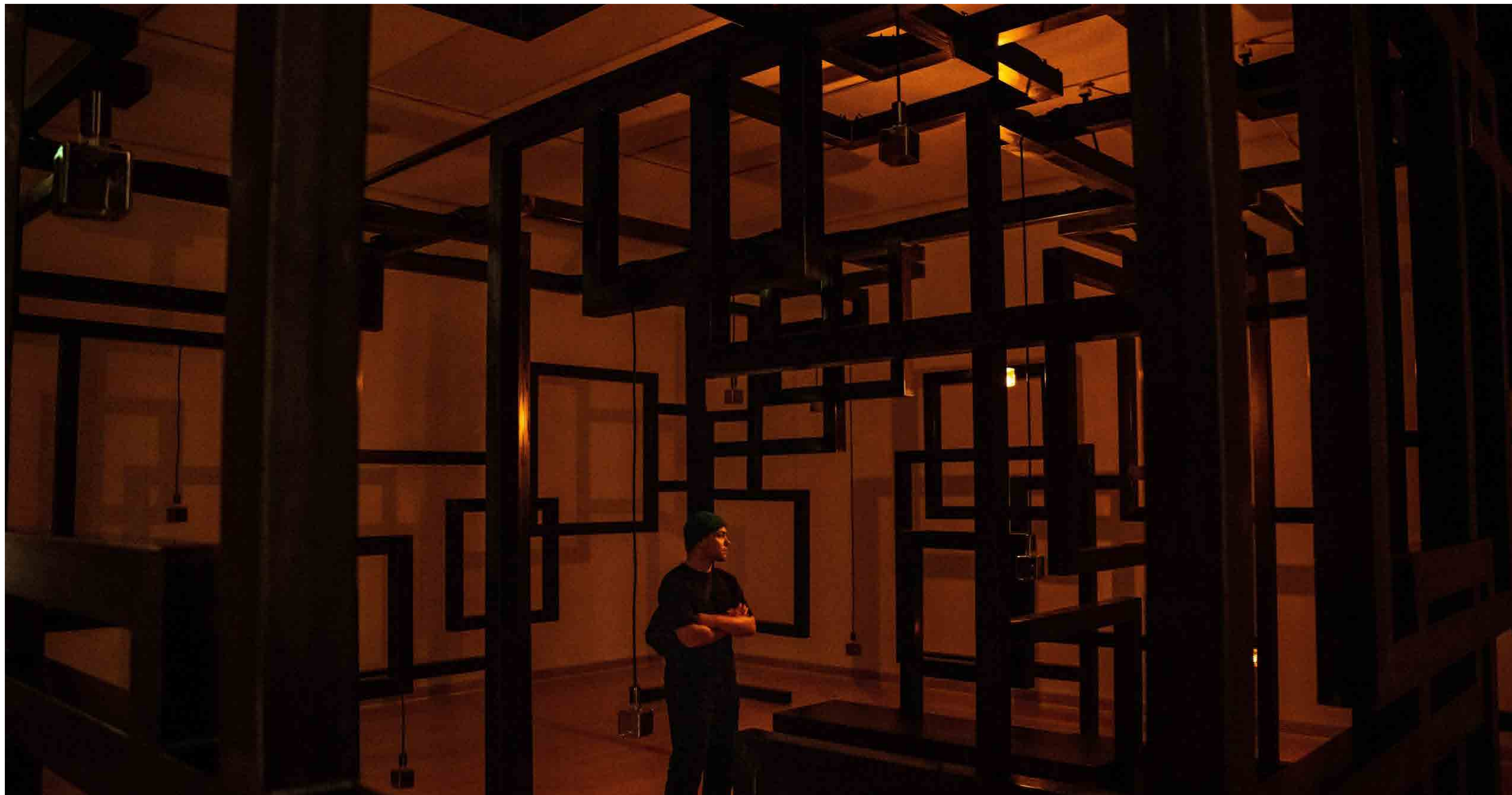


*Asking a Shadow to Dance* is a generative sculpture created in homage to Vera Molnar. The generative protocol which we focused on to create the sculpture is inspired by Vera Molnar's long standing research on the magic square mechanic found on Albert's Dürer's famous engraving *Melencolia I* (1514). We further dived into this mathematical protocol and compiled a generative algorithm to produce different paths across the magic square and generate the shapes of the sculpture.

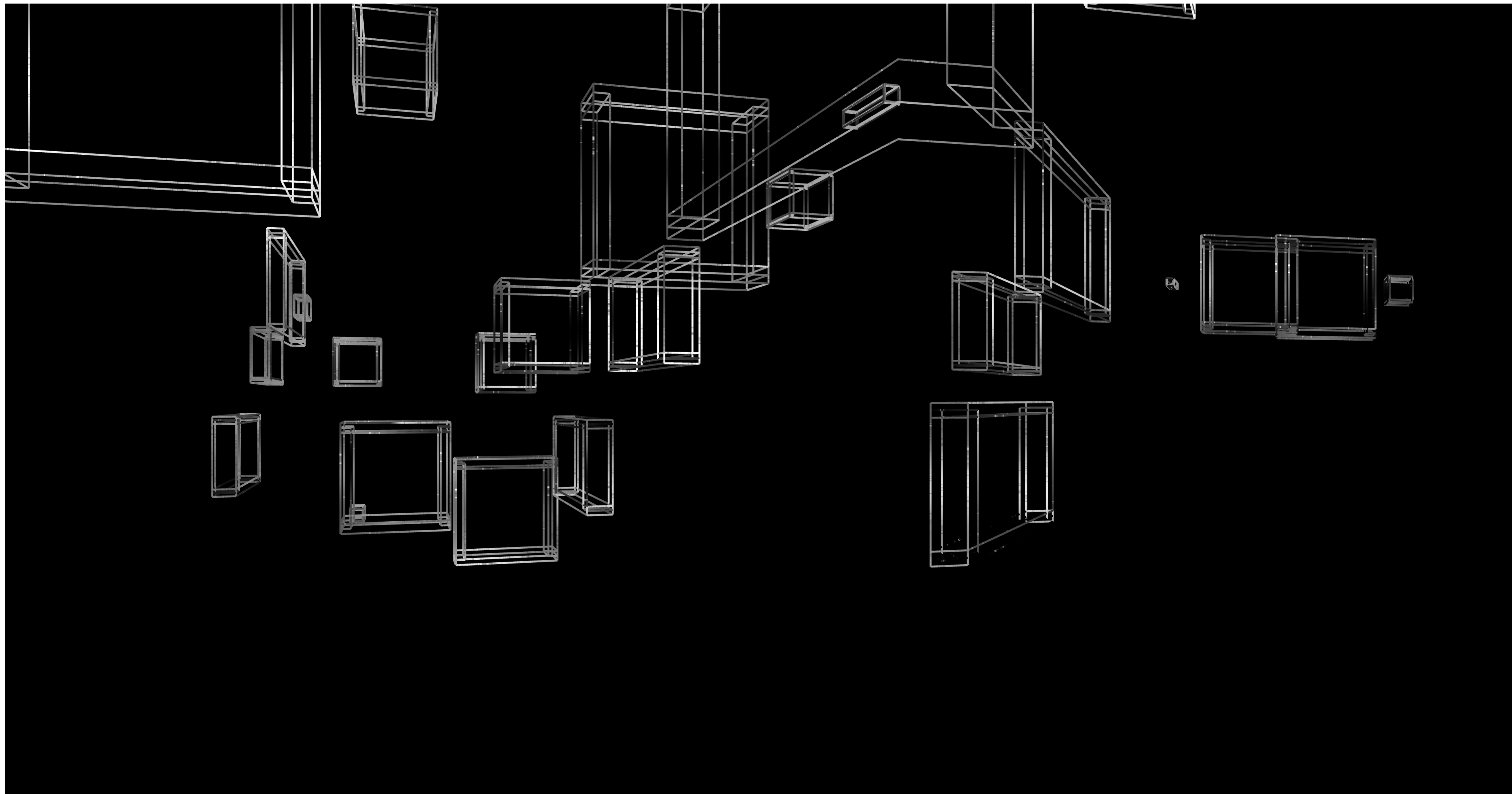
In its final form, the sculpture functions as a visual and musical instrument, creating sounds and lights that perpetuate its origin's generative process. Speakers placed inside the metal bars make the structure vibrate according to the generative magic square algorithms. The movements of the light and sound are drifting across the geometrical steel layers of the structure, creating abstract and sensible synesthetic iterations.

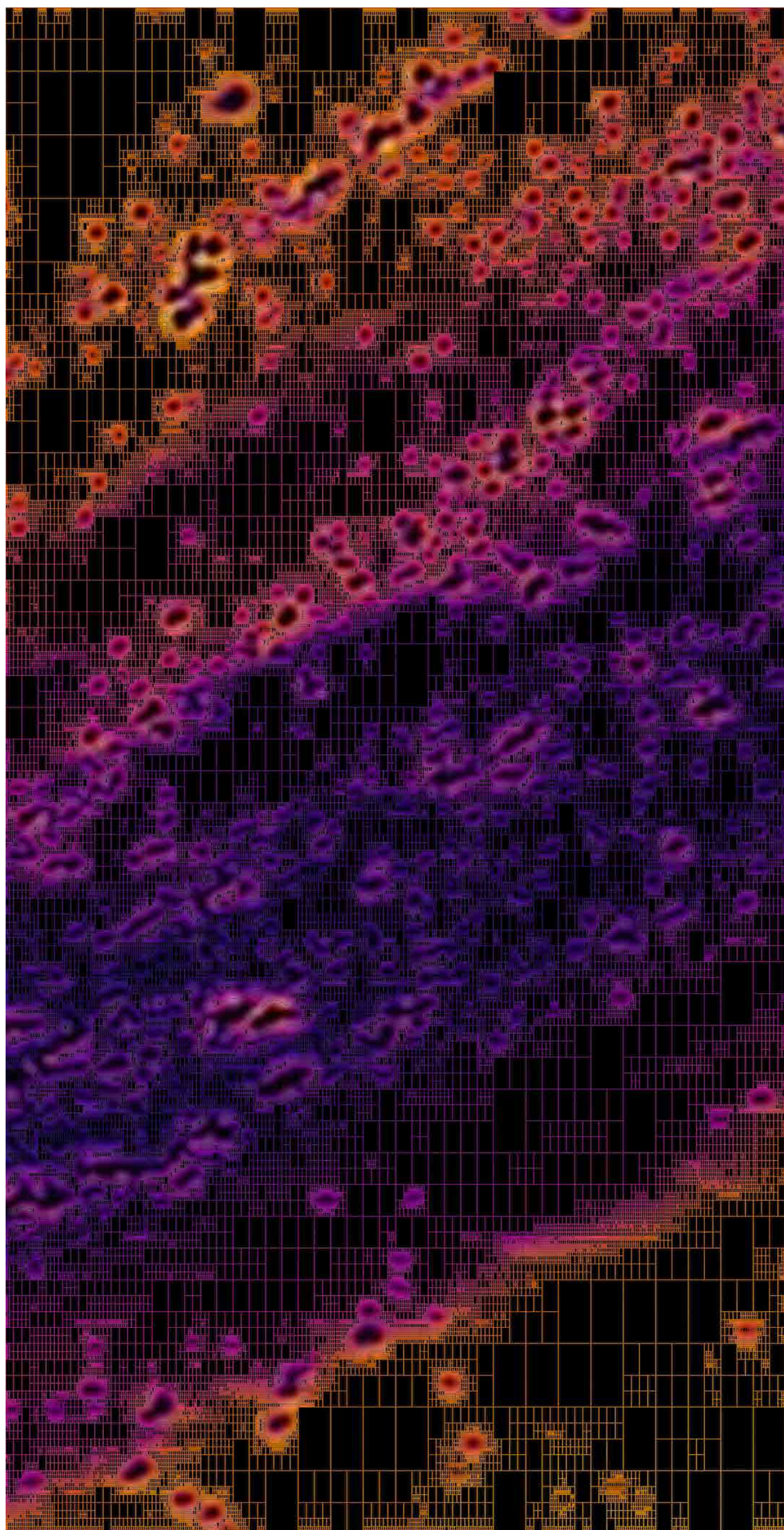
*You're very special* is a documentary movie recounting the day of the Capitol Attack on January 6, 2021. Questioning the processes of political construction of reality in the post-truth era, the documentary is made up of cross-testimonies from the different perspectives of the day.

All of the textual, visual and audio archives were generated synthetically, made by the members of a LLM production team, together translating semantic and symbolic signs of the event, from scripting to visual interpretations. An immersion into computational memory and the seething world of contemporary information. In this sense, *You're Very Special* is an endeavor into the implications of automated cinema.

# The Cursed Share

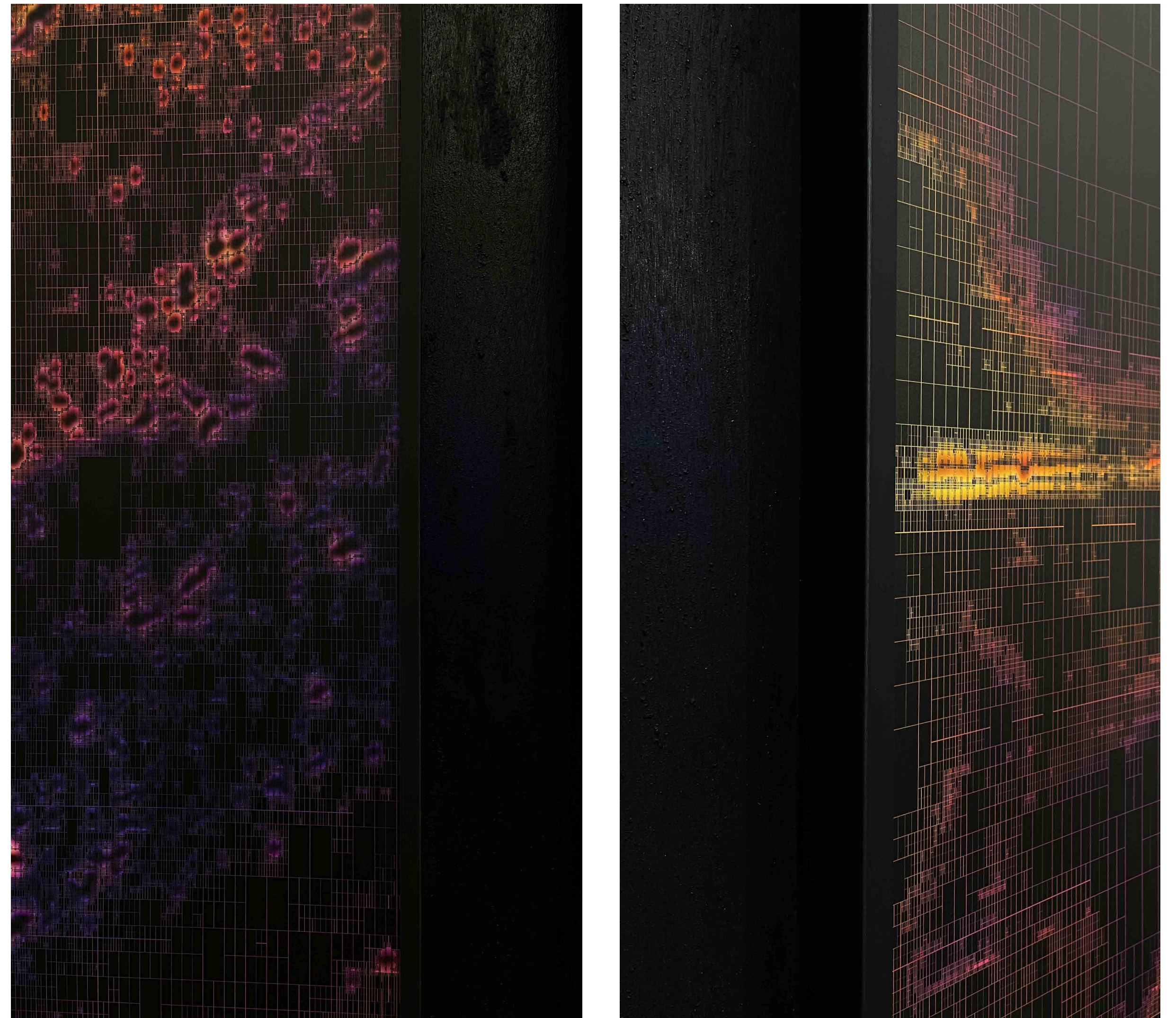

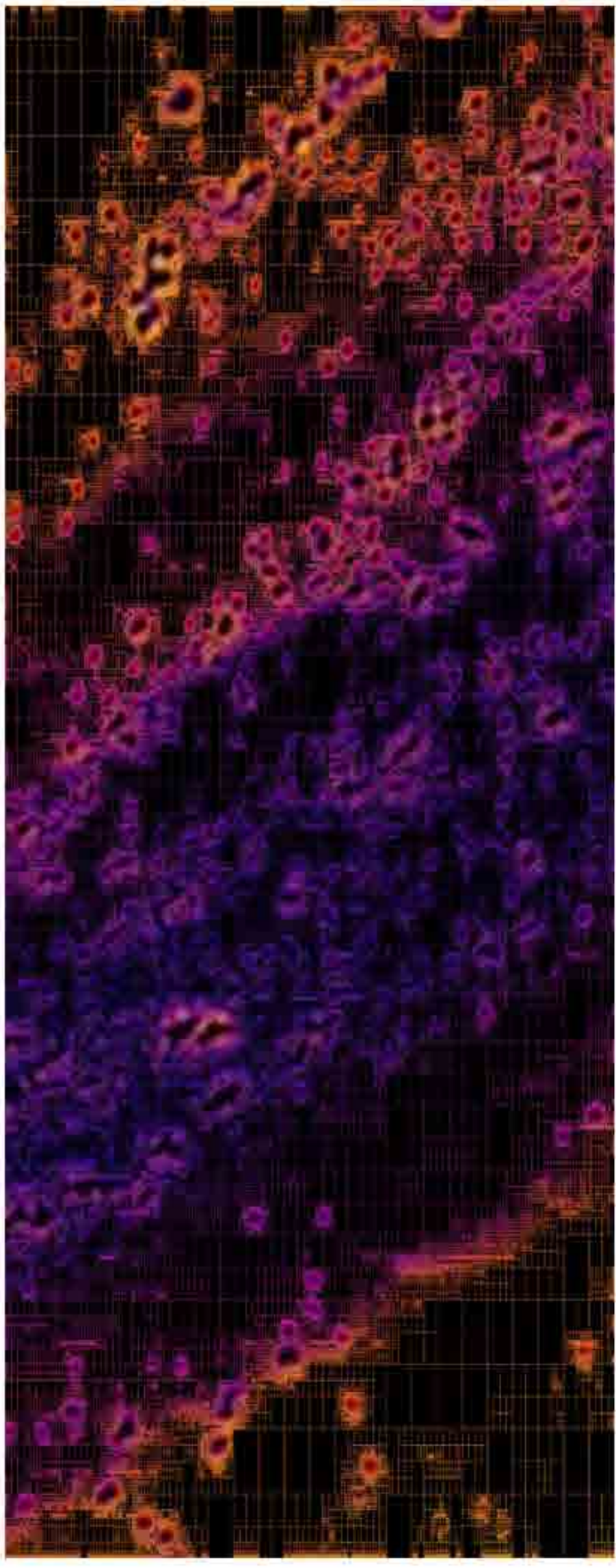
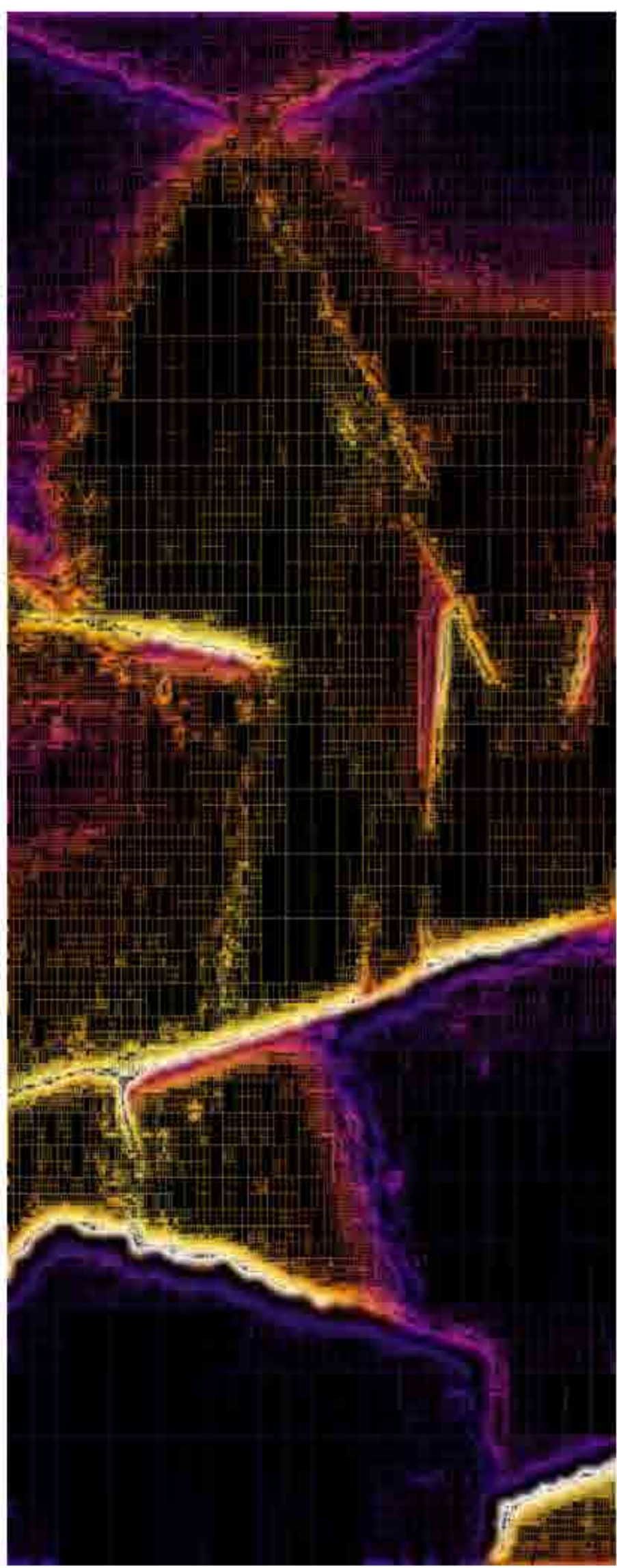
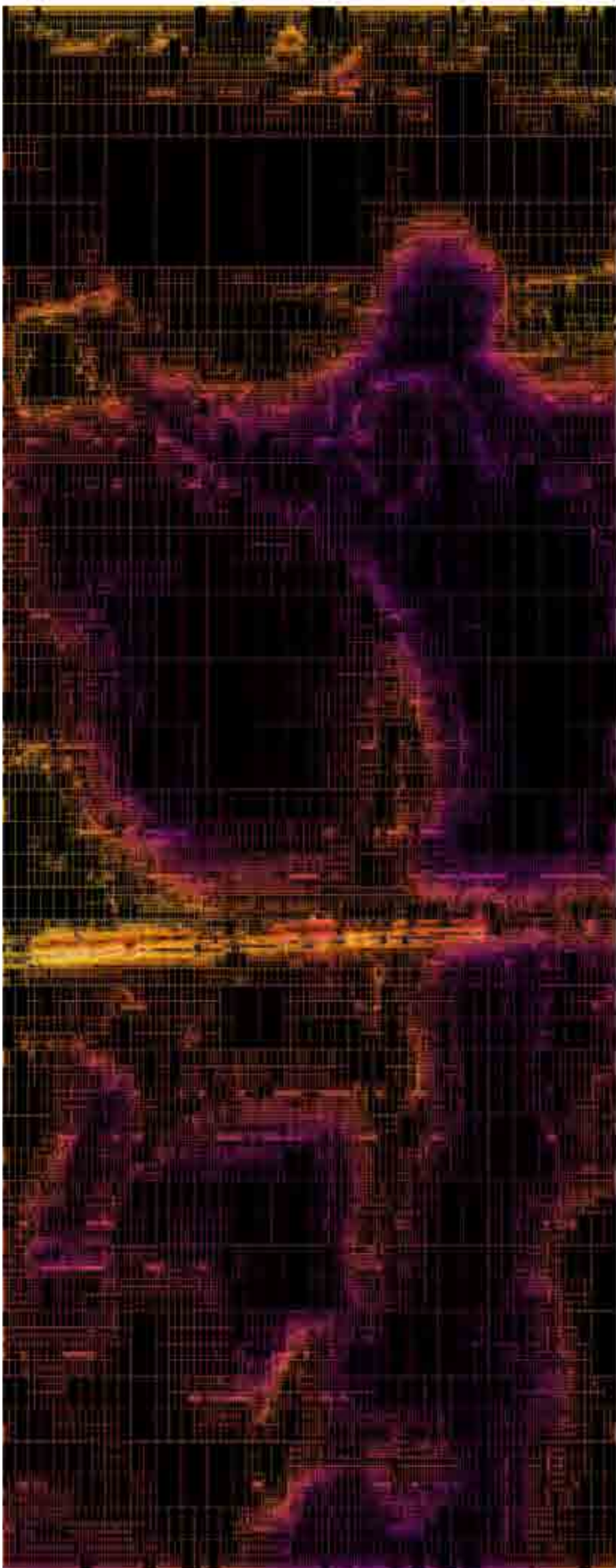


This photographic series, captured by a thermal camera and interpreted by a QuadTree algorithm, is inspired by Georges Bataille's concept of «expenditure» to explore the world of blockchain, a technology whose robustness and inviolability closely depend on energy expenditure. In reference to the relationship between thermodynamics and information theory, this series establishes a formal link between value and sacrifice, the concepts of energy and information.

Thermal cameras, by capturing temperature fluctuations, translate the thermal variations of a scene. Areas with marked temperature differences, and therefore significant energy variations, are dense in information. The QuadTree algorithm segments these images, highlighting the intensities of thermal gradients with detailed nodes, while more homogeneous areas, indicating lesser energy variations, are simplified to the extreme.

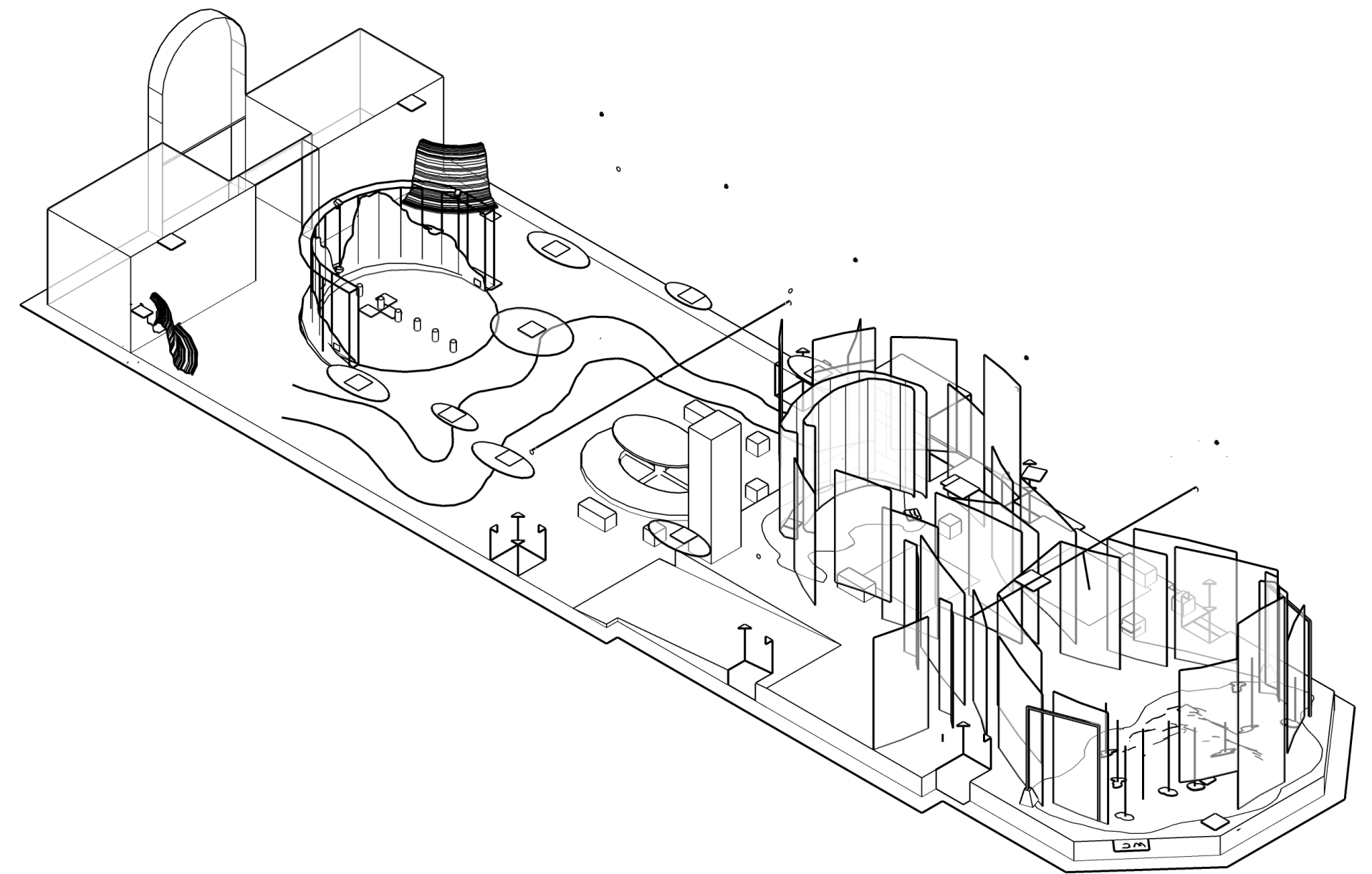




*On ne peut empêcher les oiseaux...* offers an exploration of the protected site of Vieux Salins d'Hyères through an installation designed as a documentary investigation.

This multimedia and plastic installation that functions as an continuous system is an attempt to implement the philosophical concept of multi-perspectivism through immersive devices. Multi-perspectivism asserts that absolutely all the elements that inhabit an environment are defined by a certain perspective on that environment, a certain relationship with it, a certain function in the ecosystem.

For several months, u2p050 conducted visual and sound recordings of the activities intersecting at the Vieux Salins, whether they are human, animal, plant, mineral, or technological. They observed and recorded this place by multiplying techniques and points of view, each representing different interpretations of reality, showcasing the richness and complexity of this environment. *On ne peut empêcher les oiseaux...* attempts to give us the opportunity to perceive and think about metaphysics that are intertwined and do not privilege any one point of view on the world, where no one among the plankton, the pink flamingo and the pope prevails over the others. No one.

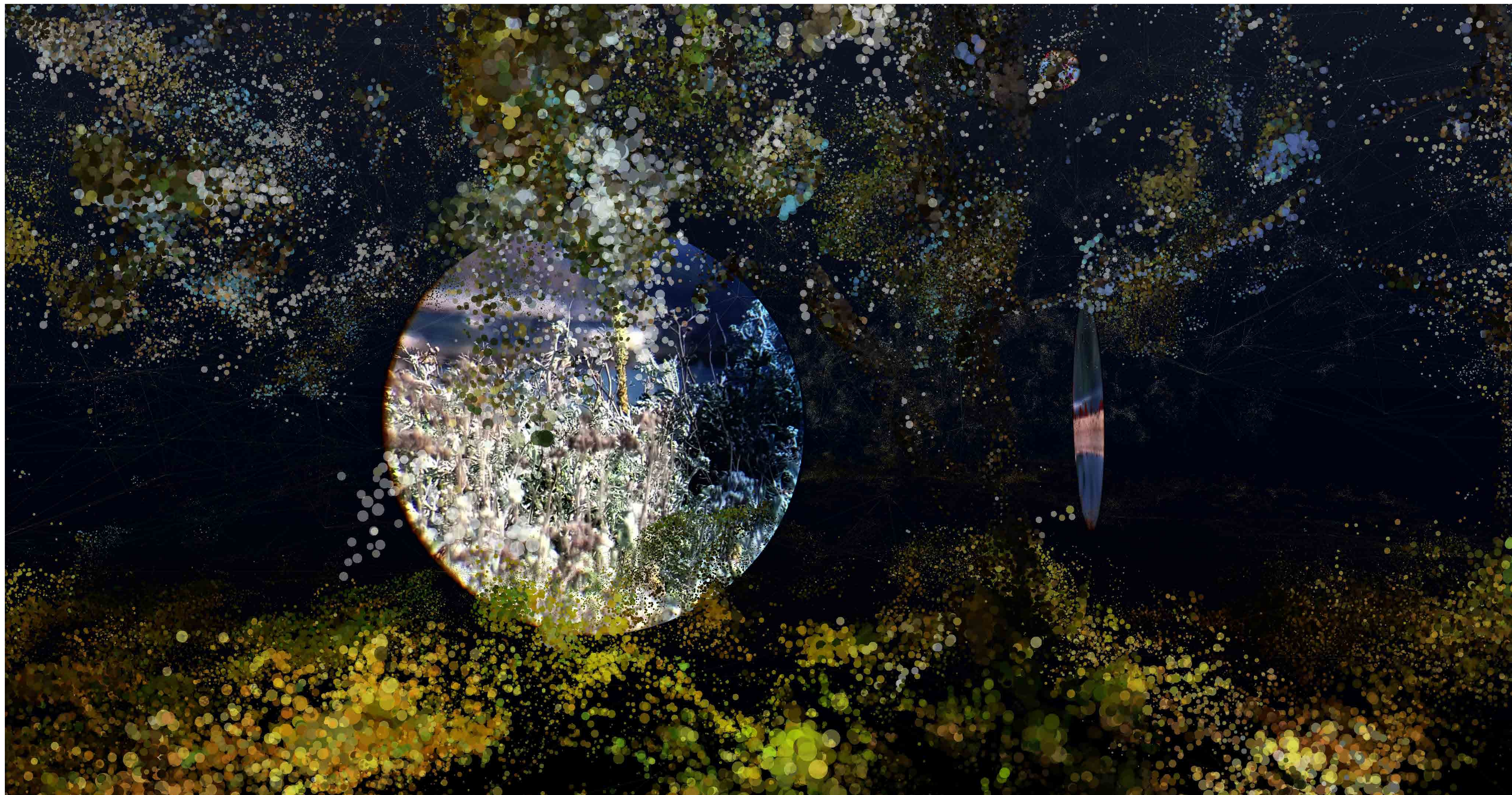

Smack dat is a humorous exploration of this troubled moment we live in, where images generated by artificial intelligence are still distinct from «real images».

Visitors will discover a series of intriguing and humorous images of political figures kissing themselves. These images, produced with artificial intelligence, represent an artistic proposal on ego and narcissism in the contemporary political world. The show features a pop-up store where visitors can purchase unique t-shirts made from the same images of political figures kissing themselves, from Zemmour to Mélenchon. A soundtrack specially designed by IA for the pop-up will brighten up customers' ears, between club music from Abercrombie&Fitch stores and playlist from Carrefour supermarkets.

As part of the promotion of the exhibition, u2p050 is also organizing a wild poster campaign in the streets of Paris to bring these images to life off-screen and give them another form of virality.

# Moebia

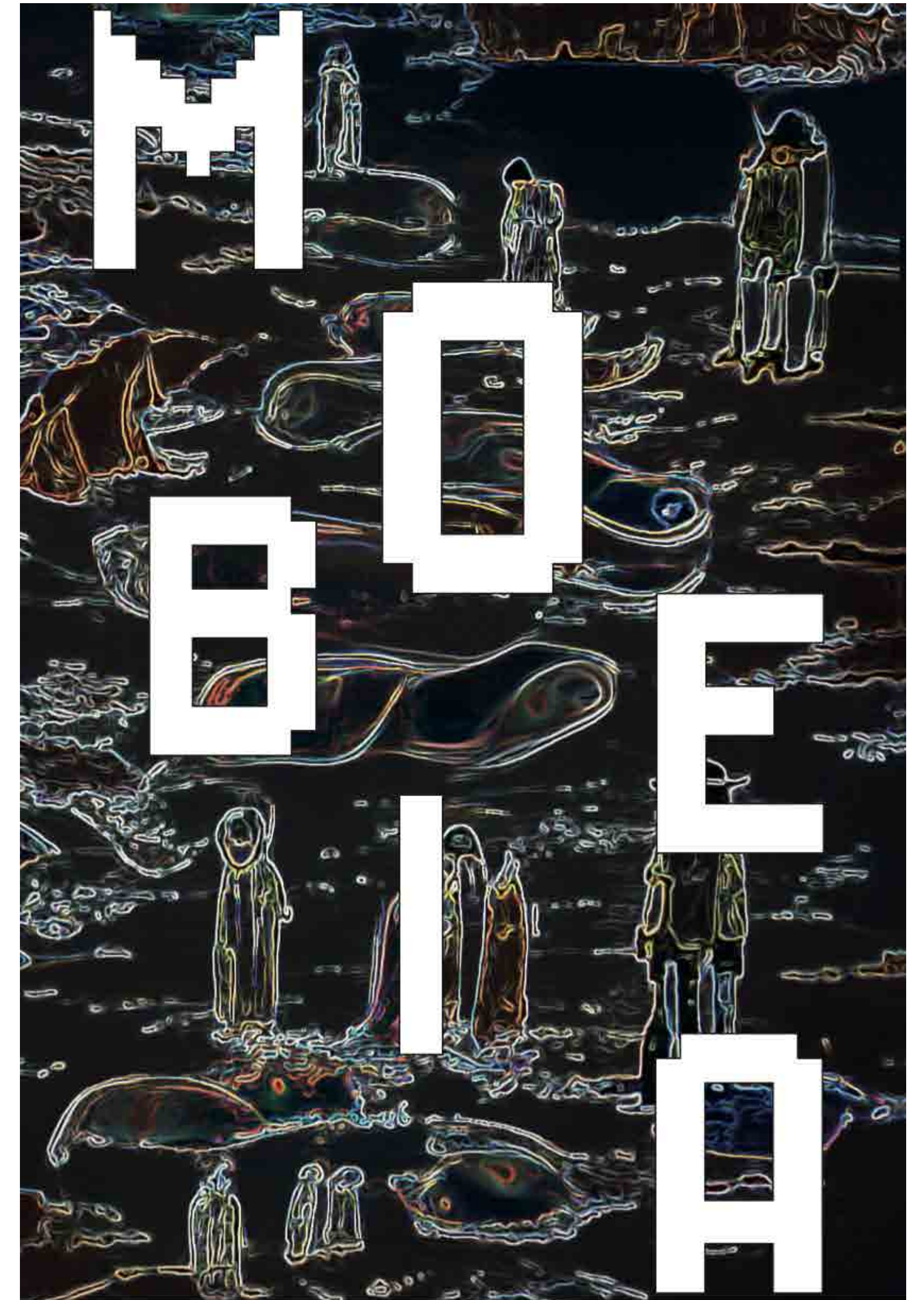

Moebia is also an attempt of fixing one of the many synthetic aesthetic by using the book medium to date the VQGAN algorithm recognizable shapes.

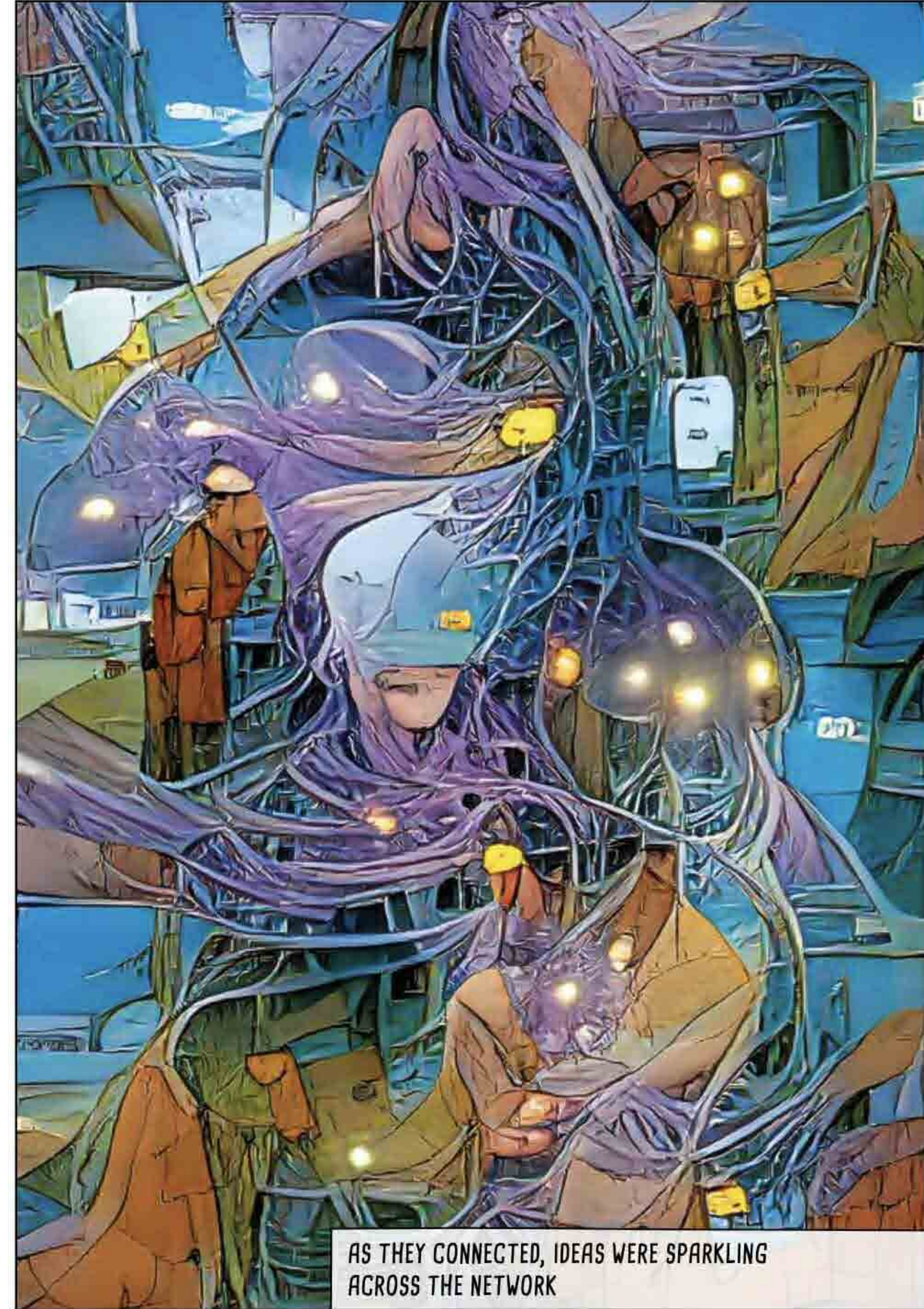
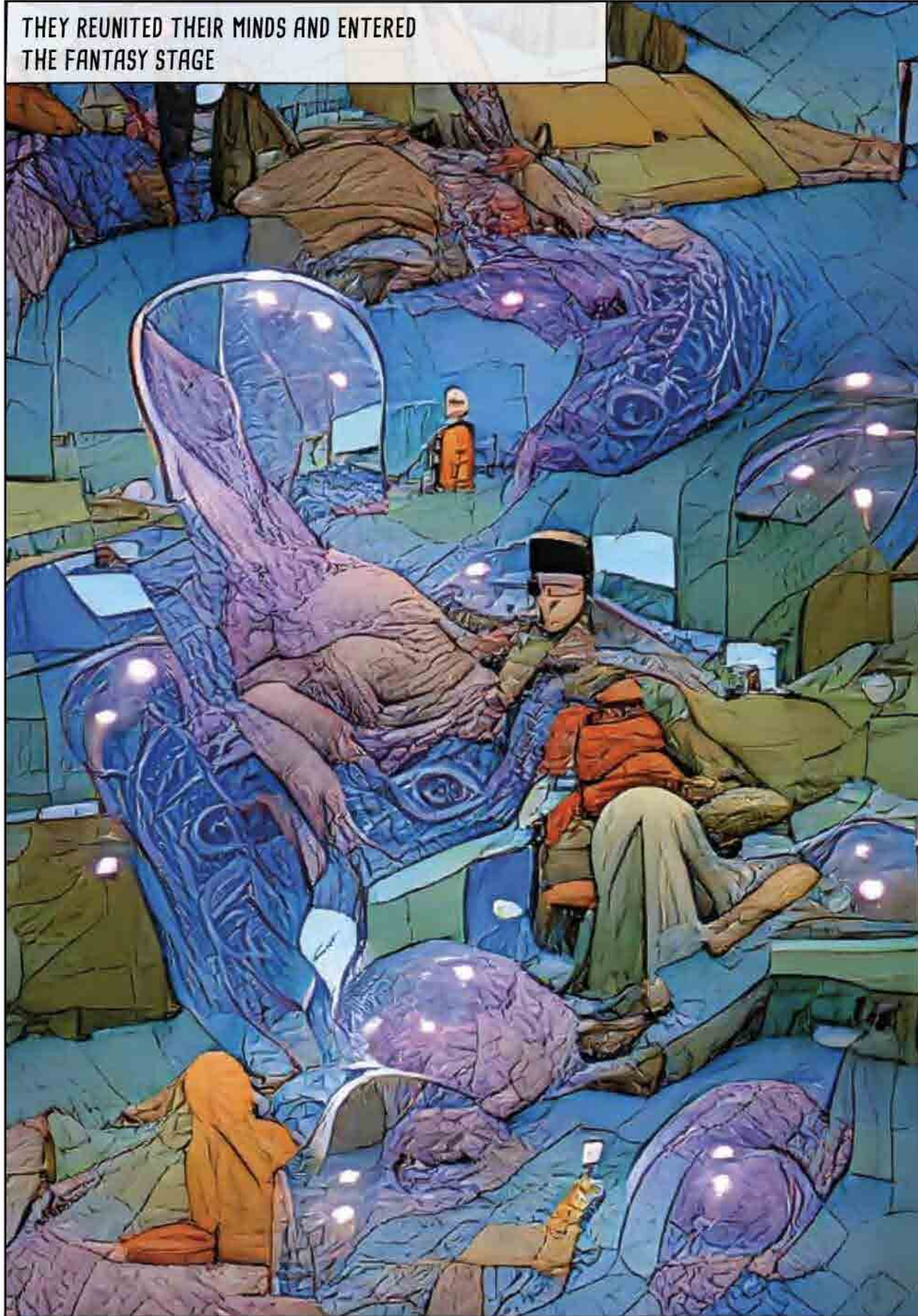






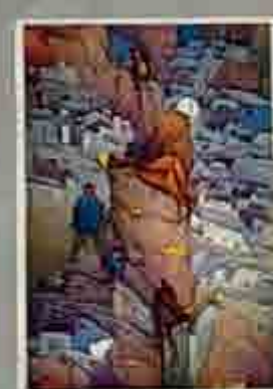
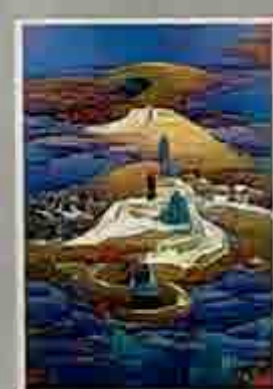

*Cryptosporidium* is an installation produced for the Avant Galerie, that aims to articulate the idea of an agricultural system where humans no longer occupy the central place they have long been assigned. u2p050 wishes to show a new cosmos including other than humans & computational agents. In a somewhat apocalyptic world in which there would be no human mediator, how does the cow, the main character whose perception we have, see herself in relation to the technical apparatus? How do they interact? What kinds of relationships are formed between animals and machines?

The creative studio u2p050 went to Picardy for several months to investigate the nature of technological transformations in milking machines, the advent of computer writing in the agricultural world, and the relationships formed between automated machines and cattle.

This approach shows the encounter between mechanical affects and animal functions in order to question our contemporary condition, which is that of the end of the Neolithic era, of a new redistribution of human/non-human, animal/inanimate relationships.

u2p050 puts in perspective that the blockchain can be compared to cellular life in the way it grows. Machines express themselves with signals that we do not understand yet, from a world filled with possibilities that perpetually overlap with ours. Within the frame of Avatar in Metaverse exhibition, this movie offers the spectator to experience the full potential of crypto as a new step towards a decentralized ecology. Smart contract as a way of making politics between humans, machines and animals.

Indeed, u2p050 underlines the deep link between the digitization of money, and the technological transformation of agricultural systems of exploitation. It is not a coincidence that the two events are occurring at the same time. They are one and the same transformation on the global scale of our planet.

To offer a prospective documentary archive of the exhibition, the studio u2p050 recorded a 3D guided tour of the exhibition by curator Michel Nerval. He takes the visitor into a virtual universe that connects visualizations of the milking machine in its original farm and the exhibition space of the Avant Galerie.







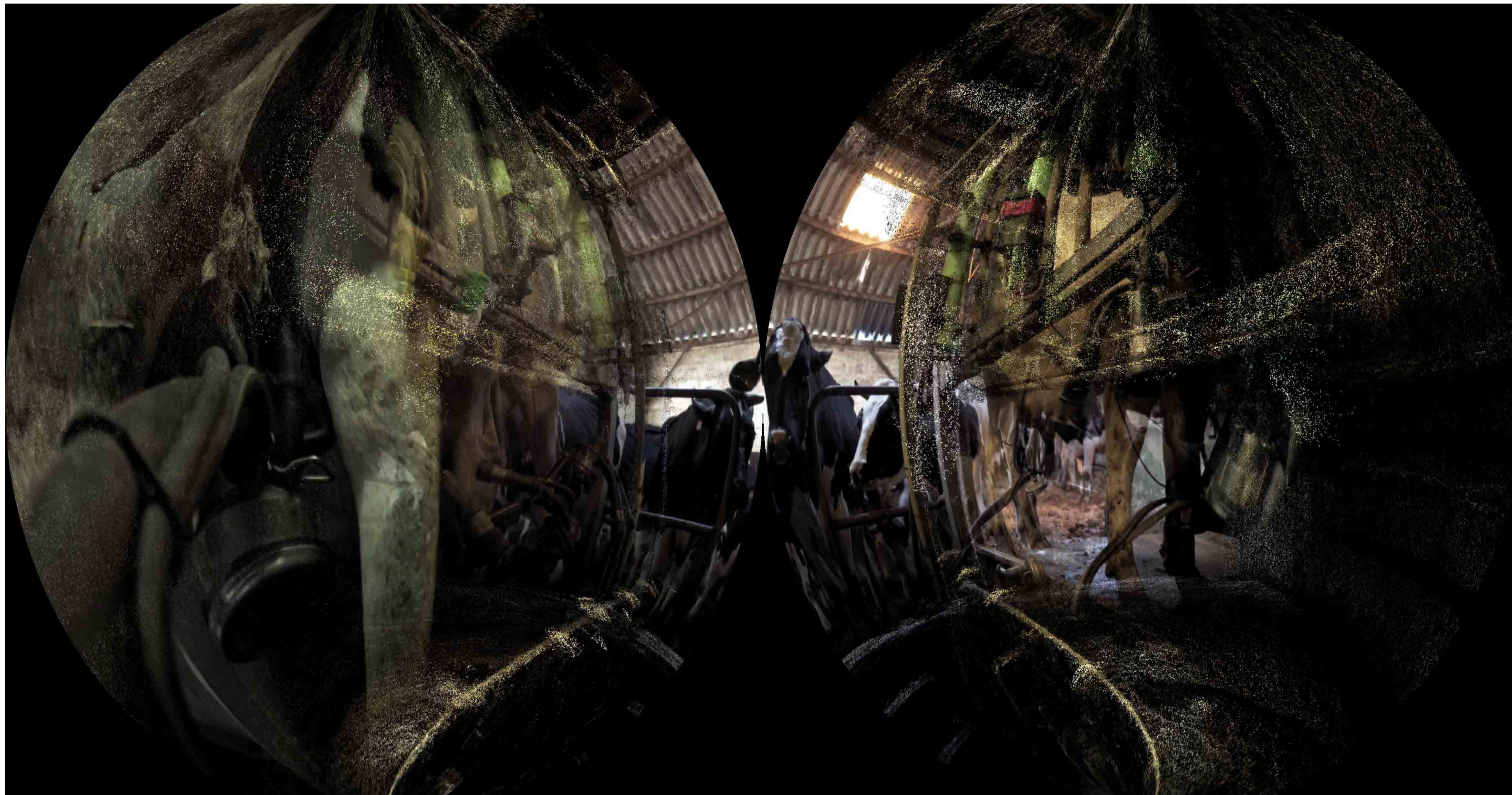

# Gan to Gan Series

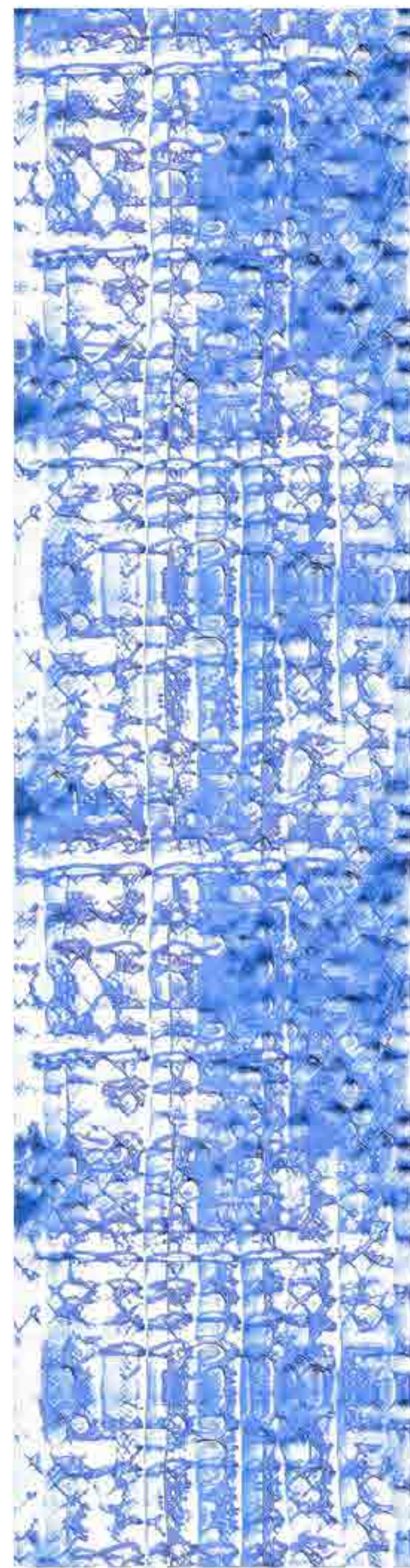


GANs are often used for their power to simulate reality. By creating fake images that could be recognized as real ones, they deliver this strong power of illusion. 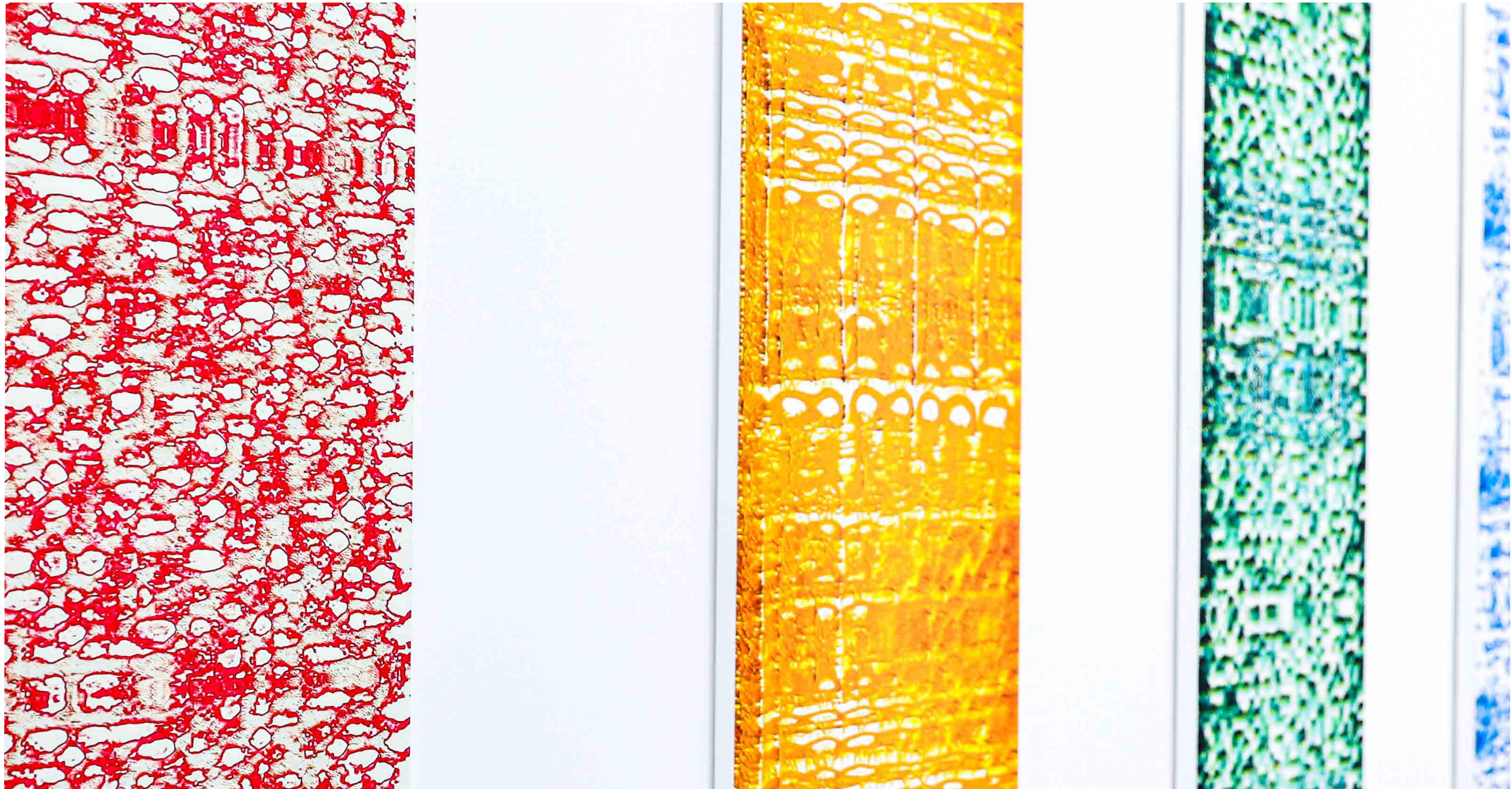
